Director of Communications Tanya Kveton recommends the Almond Cupcakes.



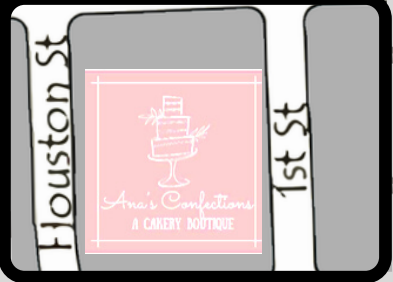
