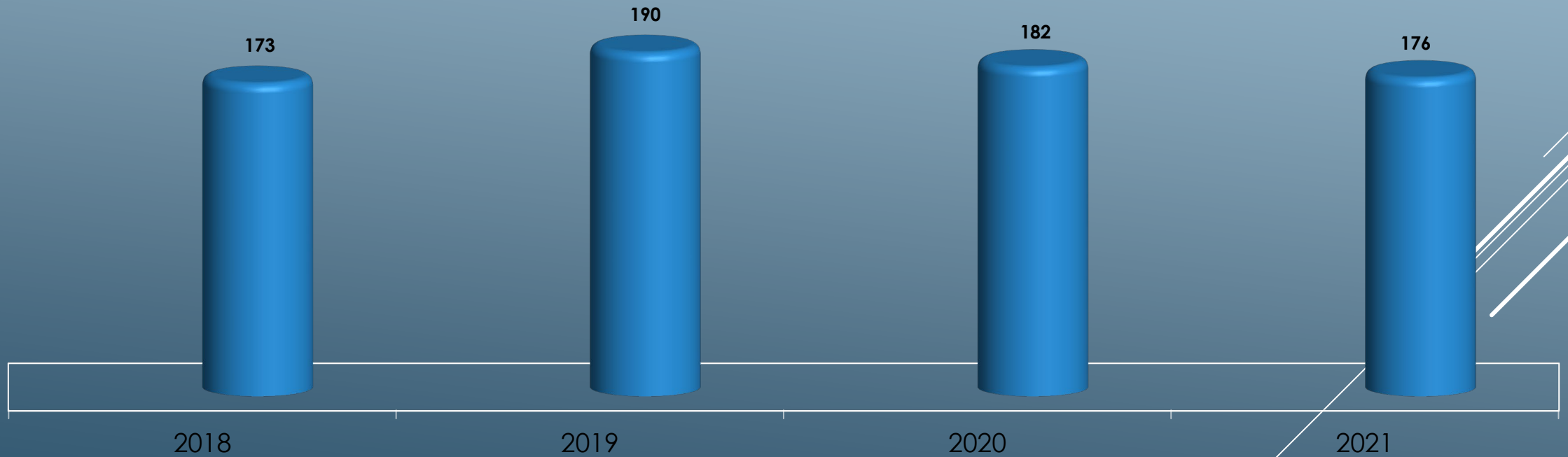

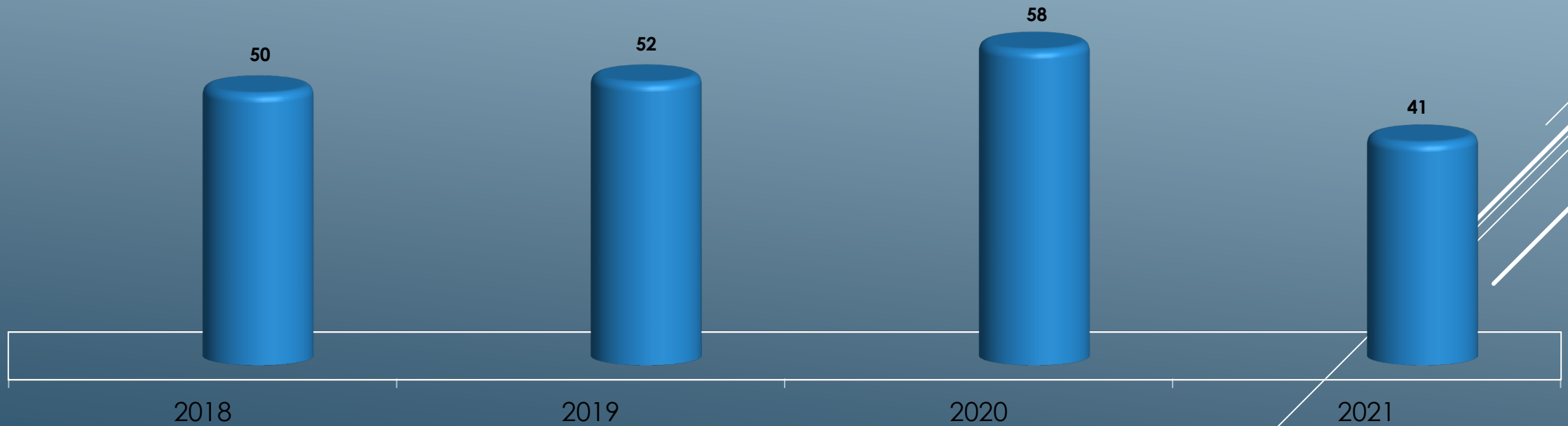

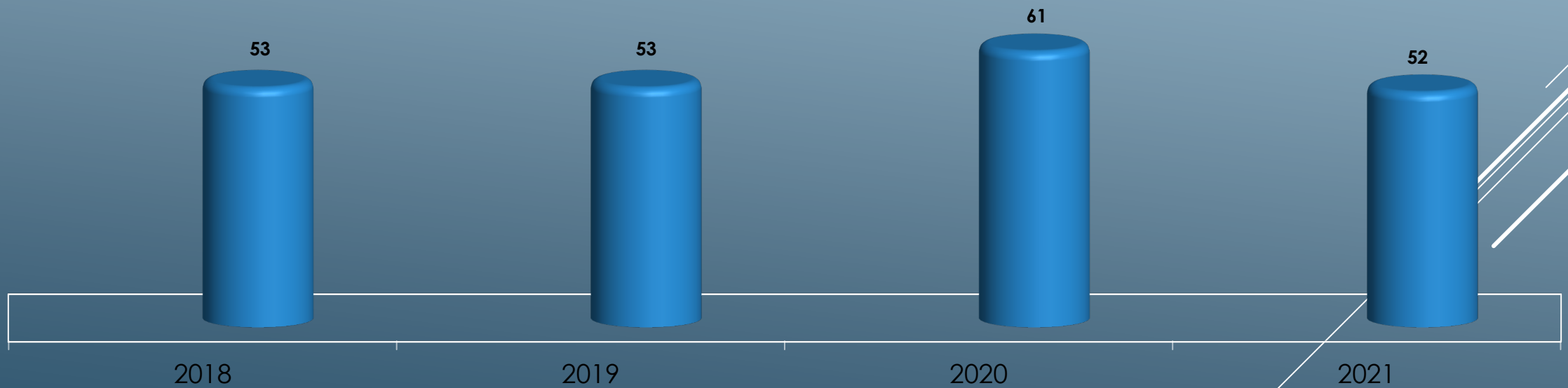
4 year comparison GROUP A for the month of June



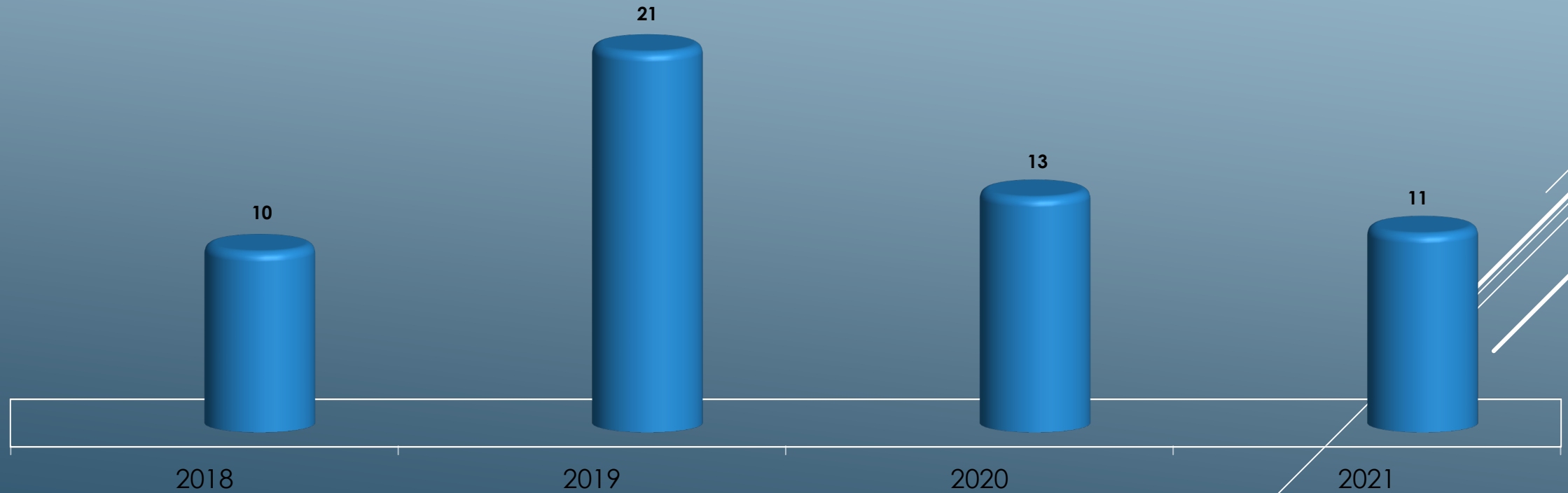
4 year comparison Property crimes for the month of June



4 year comparison Person crimes for the month of June



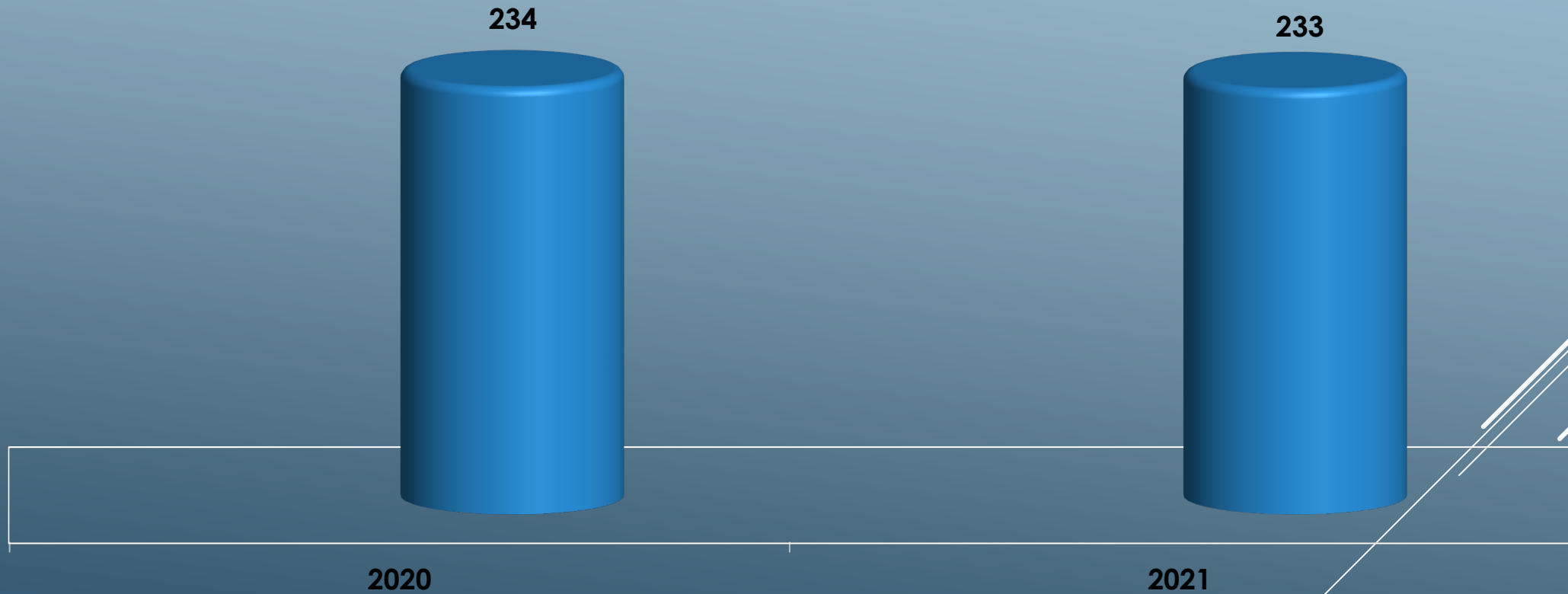
4 year comparison Violent crimes for the month of June

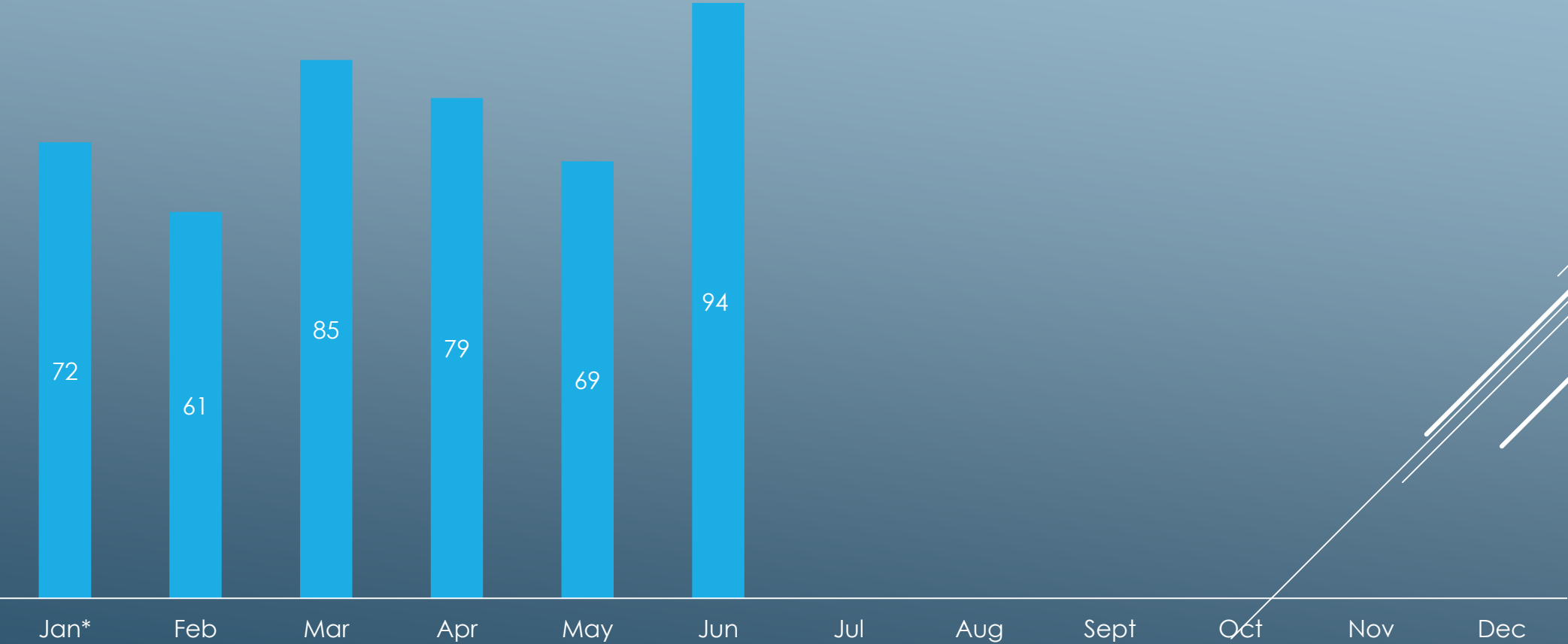

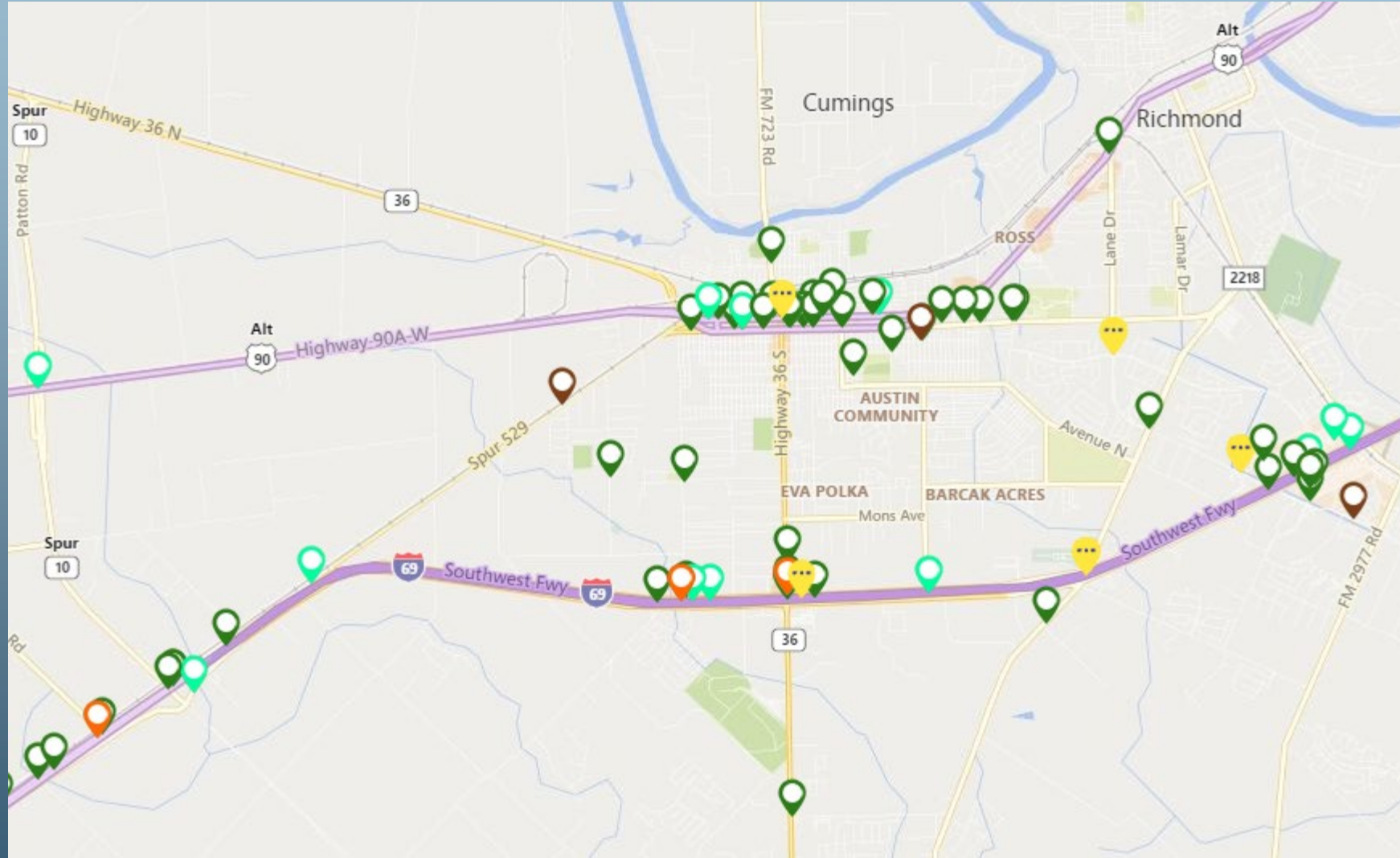

2021 Documented Crashes

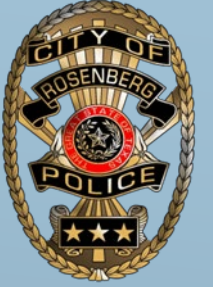

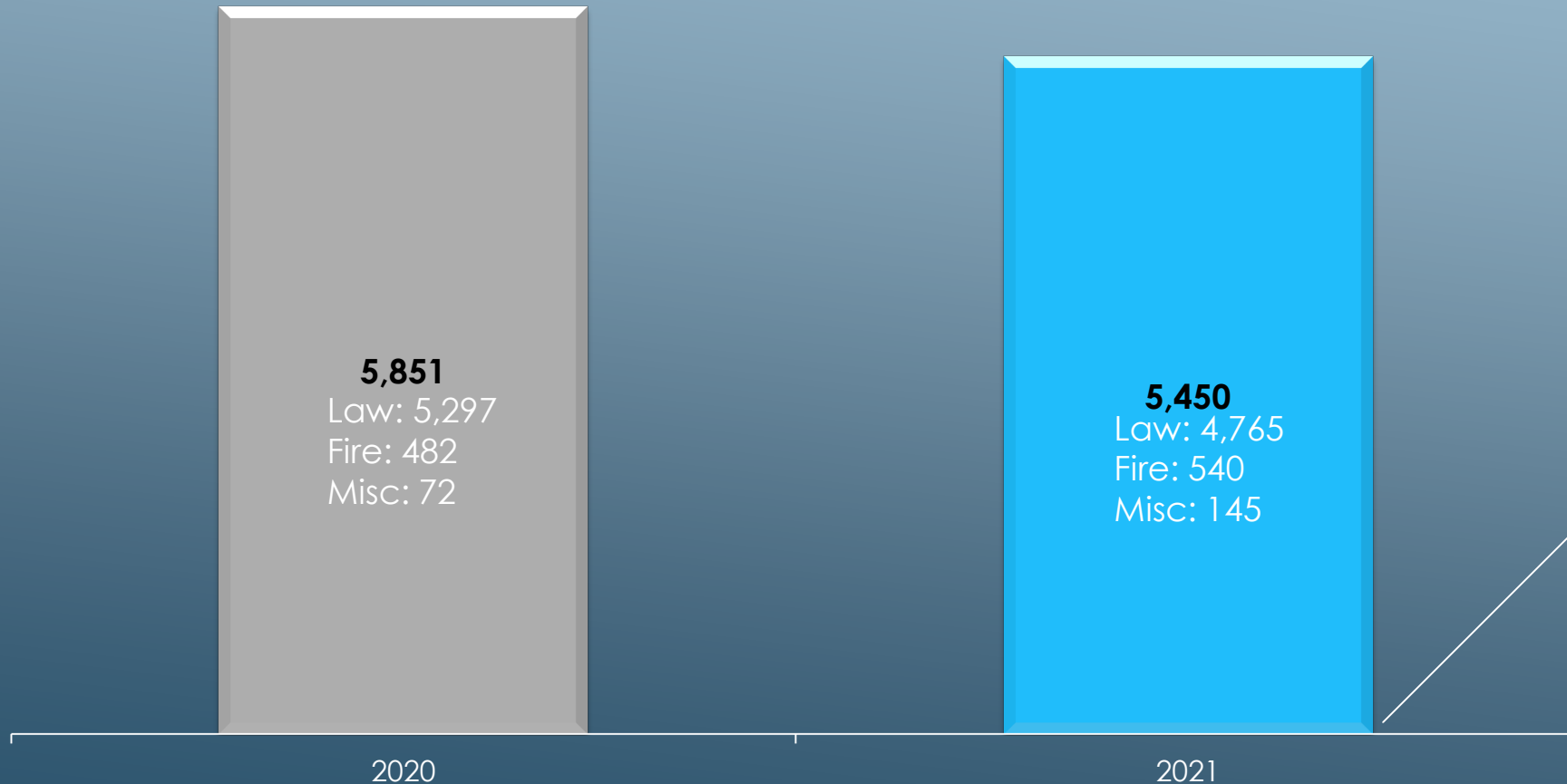
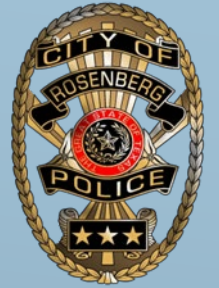
- 8 inspections were completed resulting in 27 violations.

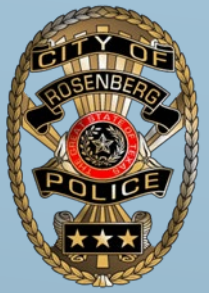
Total Emergency and Non-Emergency Calls

6 % decrease



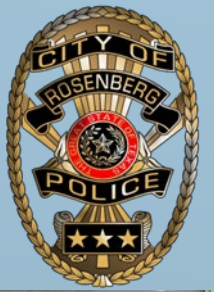
COMMUNITY RELATIONS DIVISION
