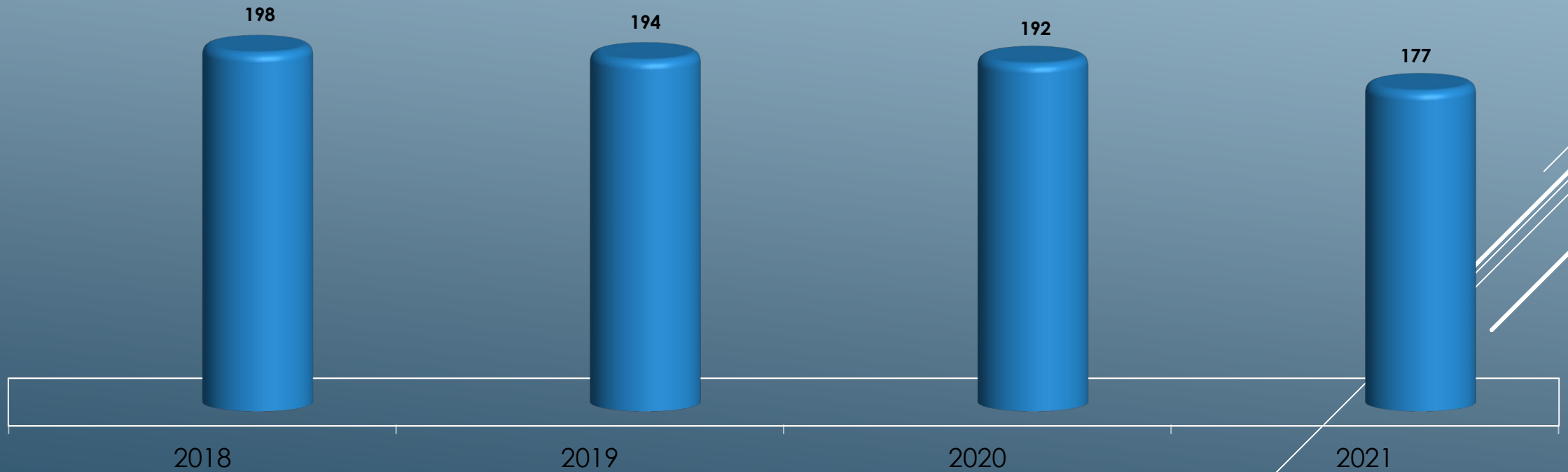

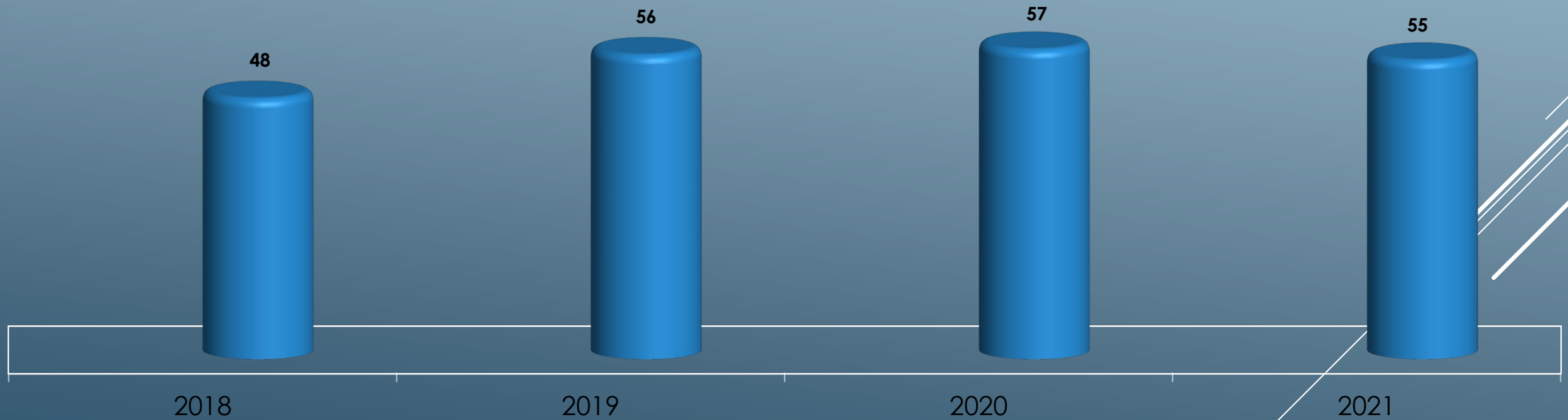

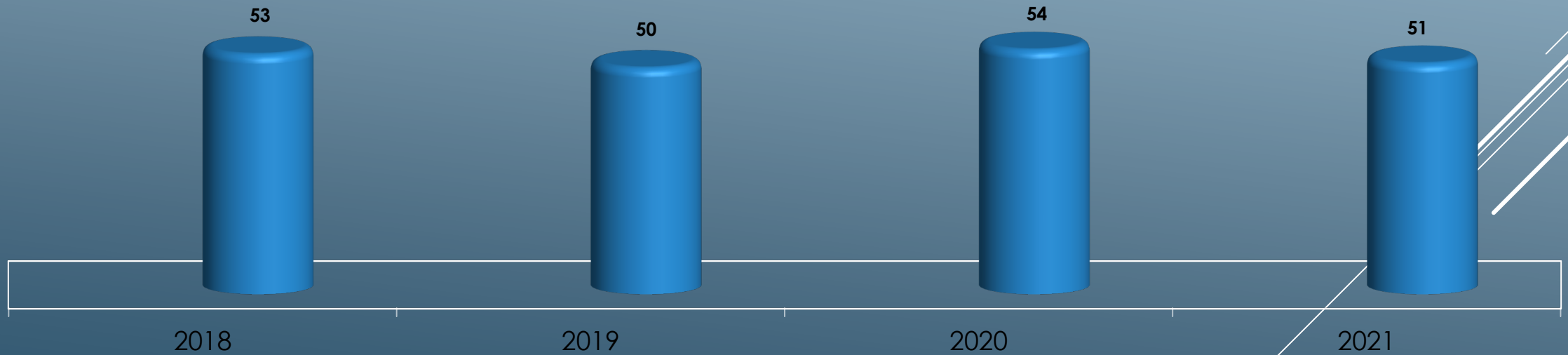
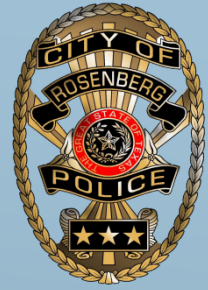
4 year comparison GROUP A for the month of July



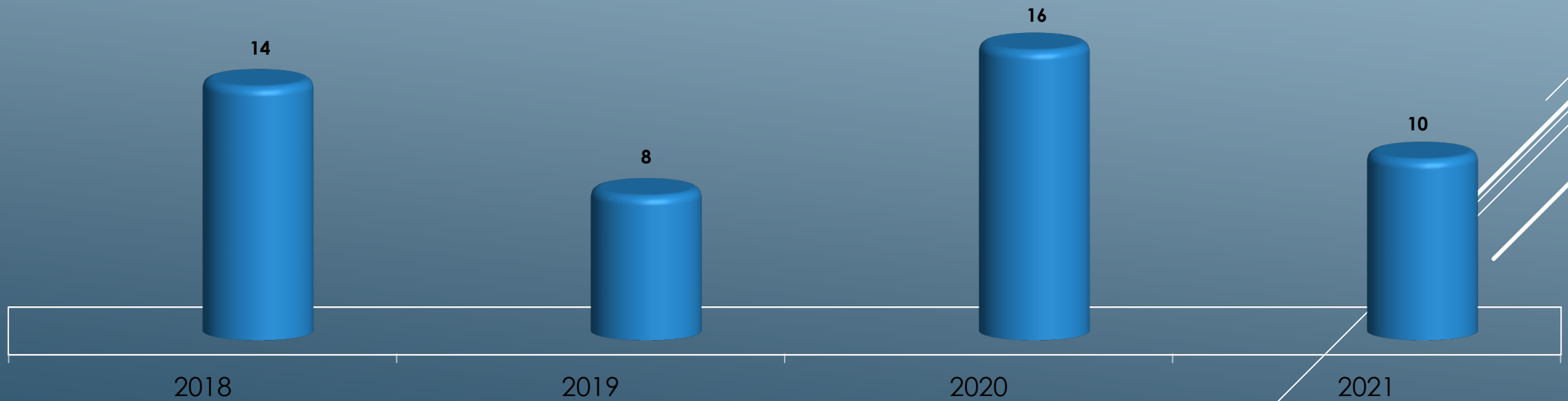
4 year comparison Property crimes for the month of July



4 year comparison Person crimes for the month of July



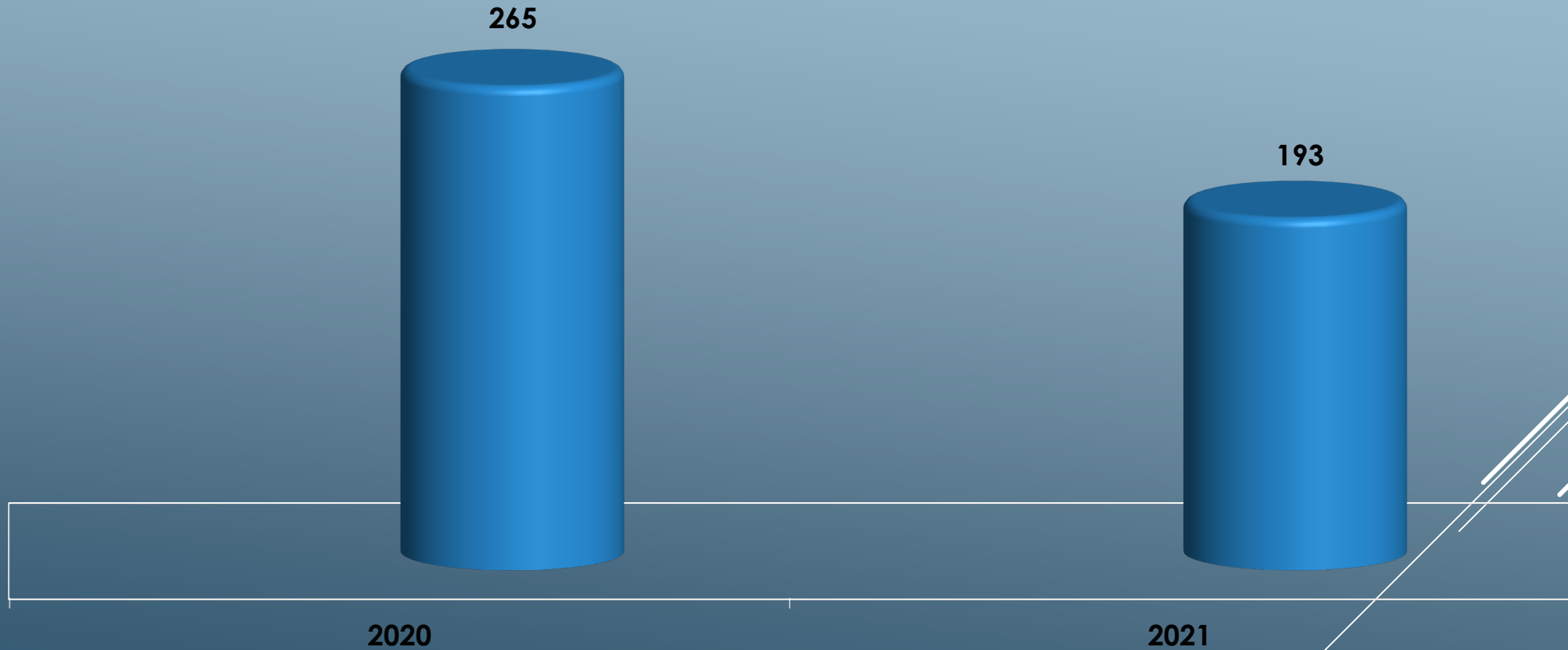
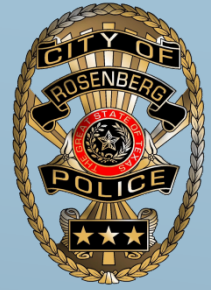
4 year comparison Violent crimes for the month of July

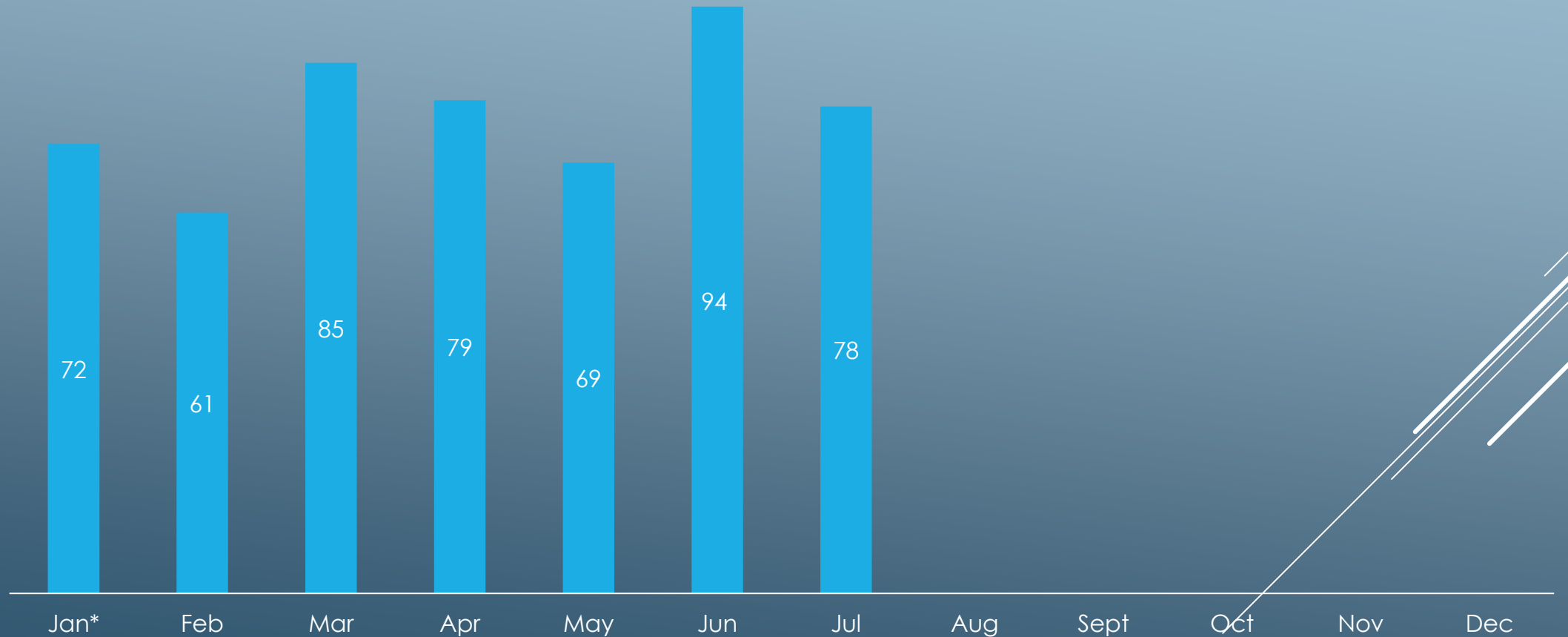
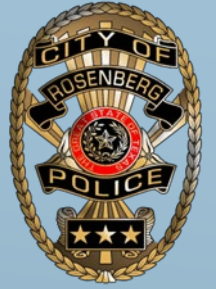

MASSAGE PARLOR INSPECTIONS

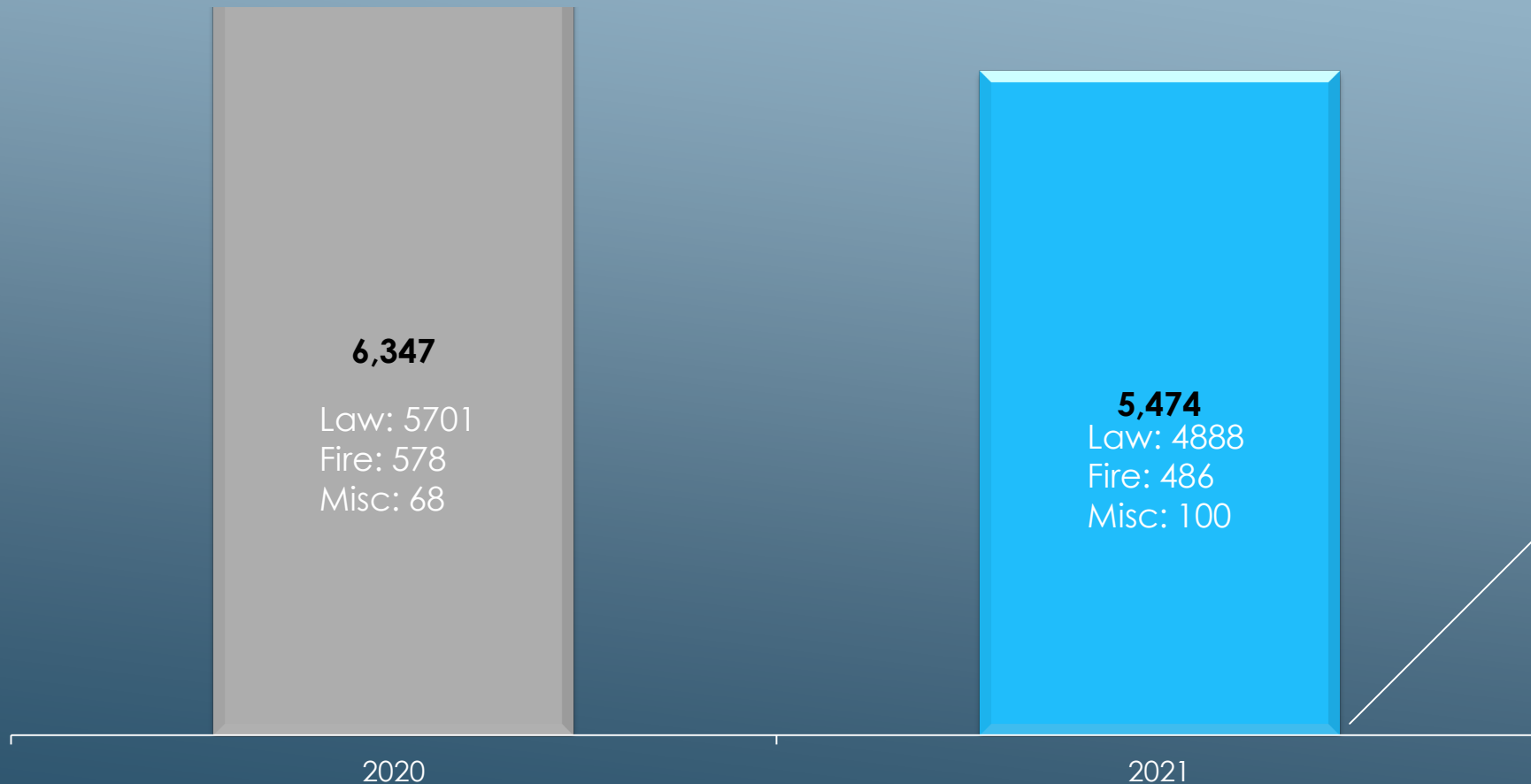
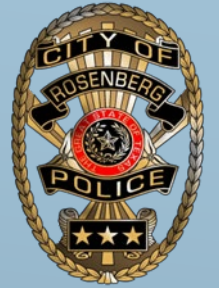


- 8 inspections were completed resulting in 18 violations.

UAV UNIT
