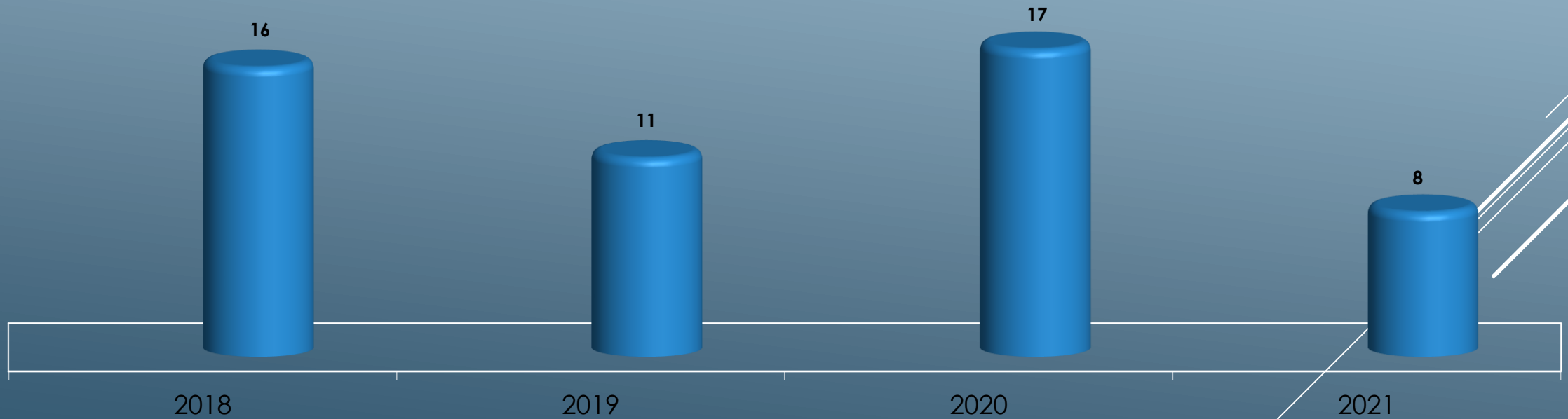
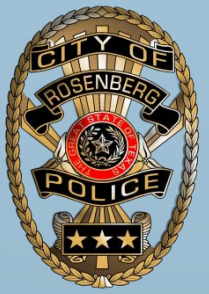
4 year comparison property crimes for the month of September



4 year comparison person crimes for the month of September

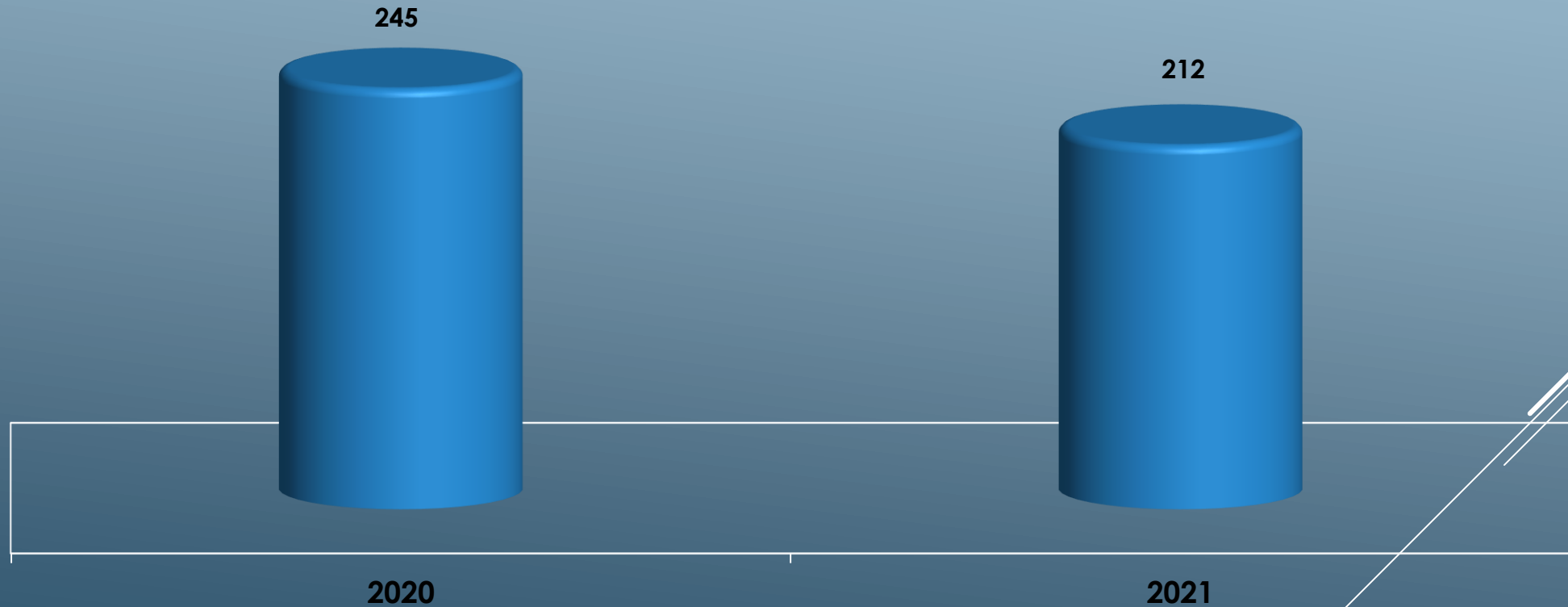
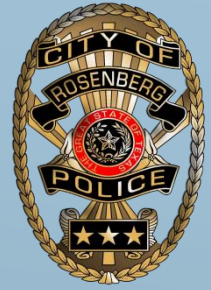


4 year comparison violent crimes for the month of September

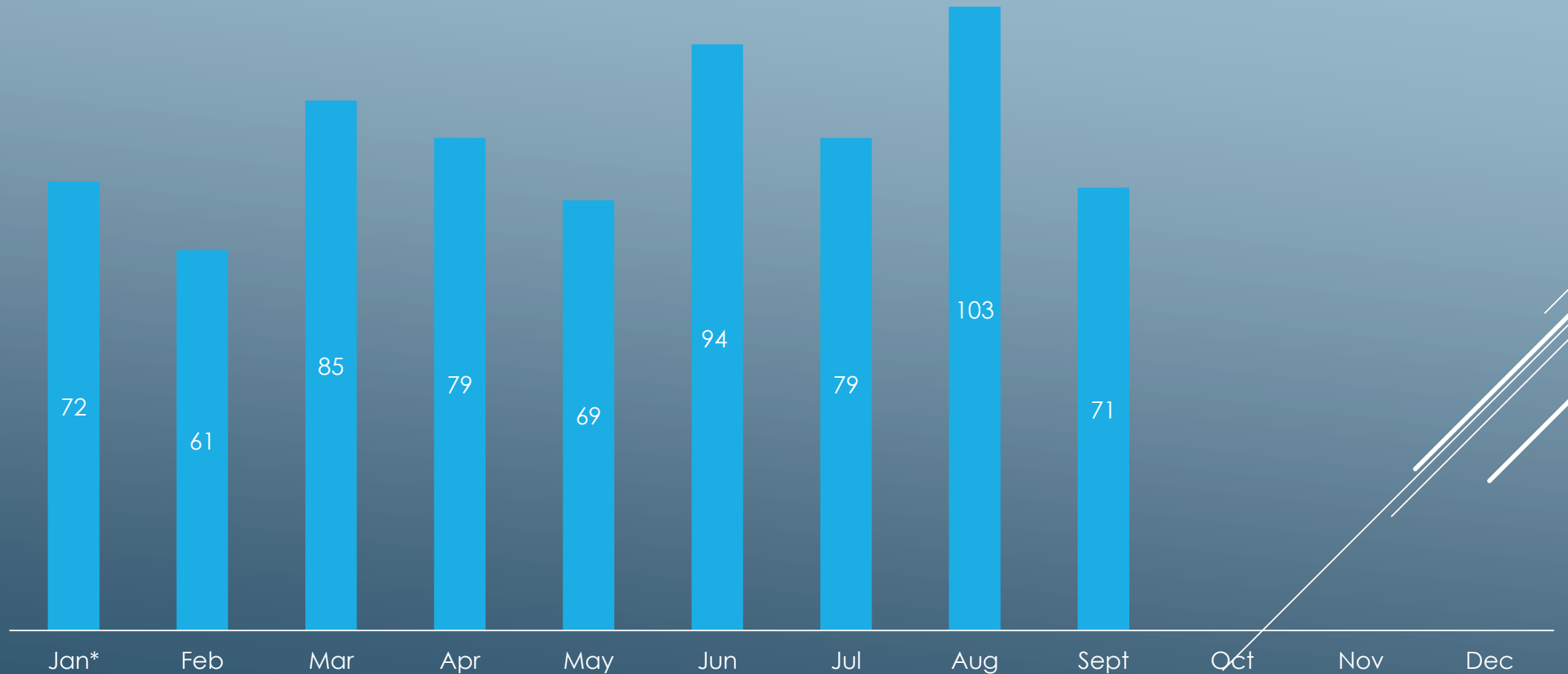

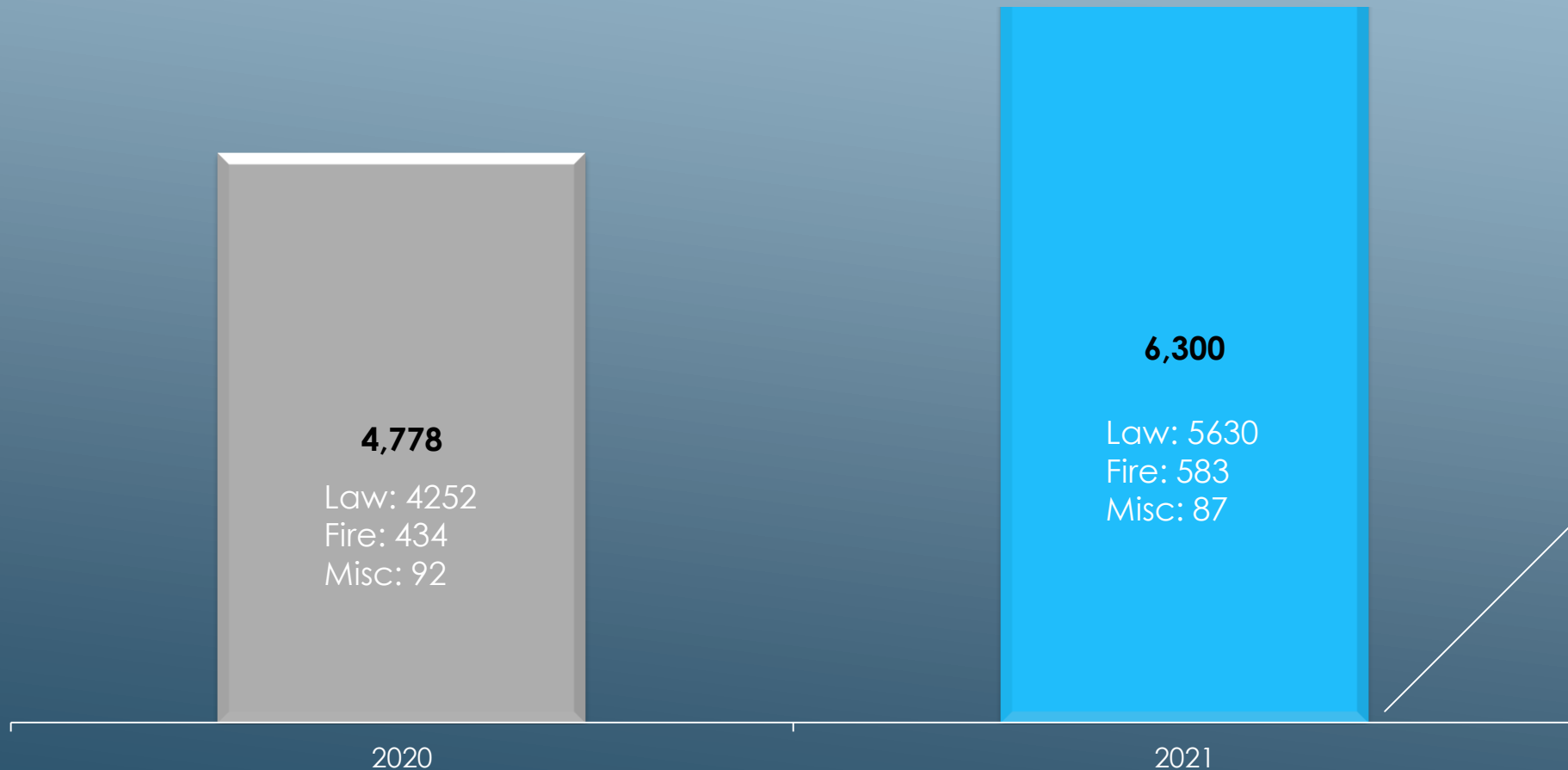

EMPLOYEES OF THE WEEK



- **Week of September 3rd** – Officer Quezada was selected for his response to a theft in progress at a retailer in Brazos Town Center. Due to Officer Quezada's response and investigation, several similar cases across the Houston area were solved.
