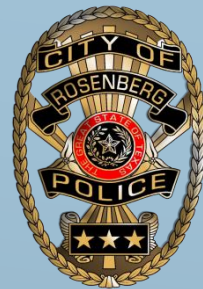


4 year comparison Property Crimes for the month of October

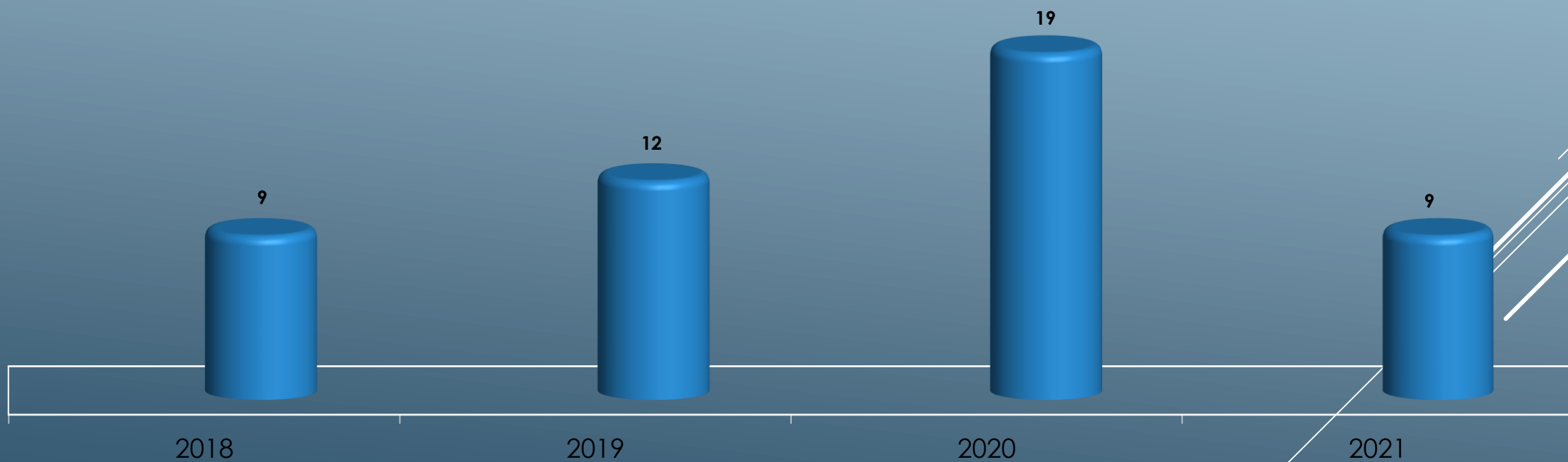


4 year comparison Person Crimes for the month of October





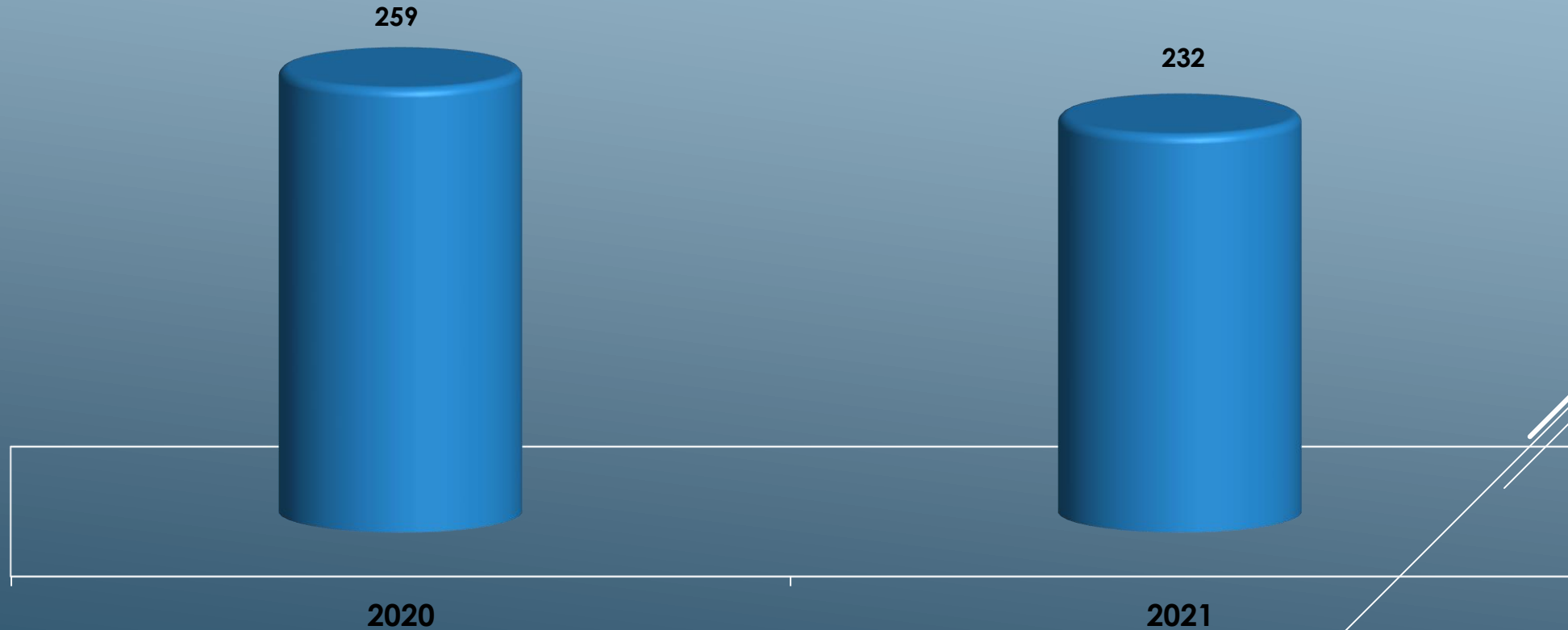
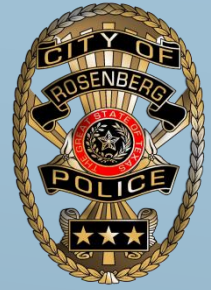
4 year comparison Violent Crimes for the month of October

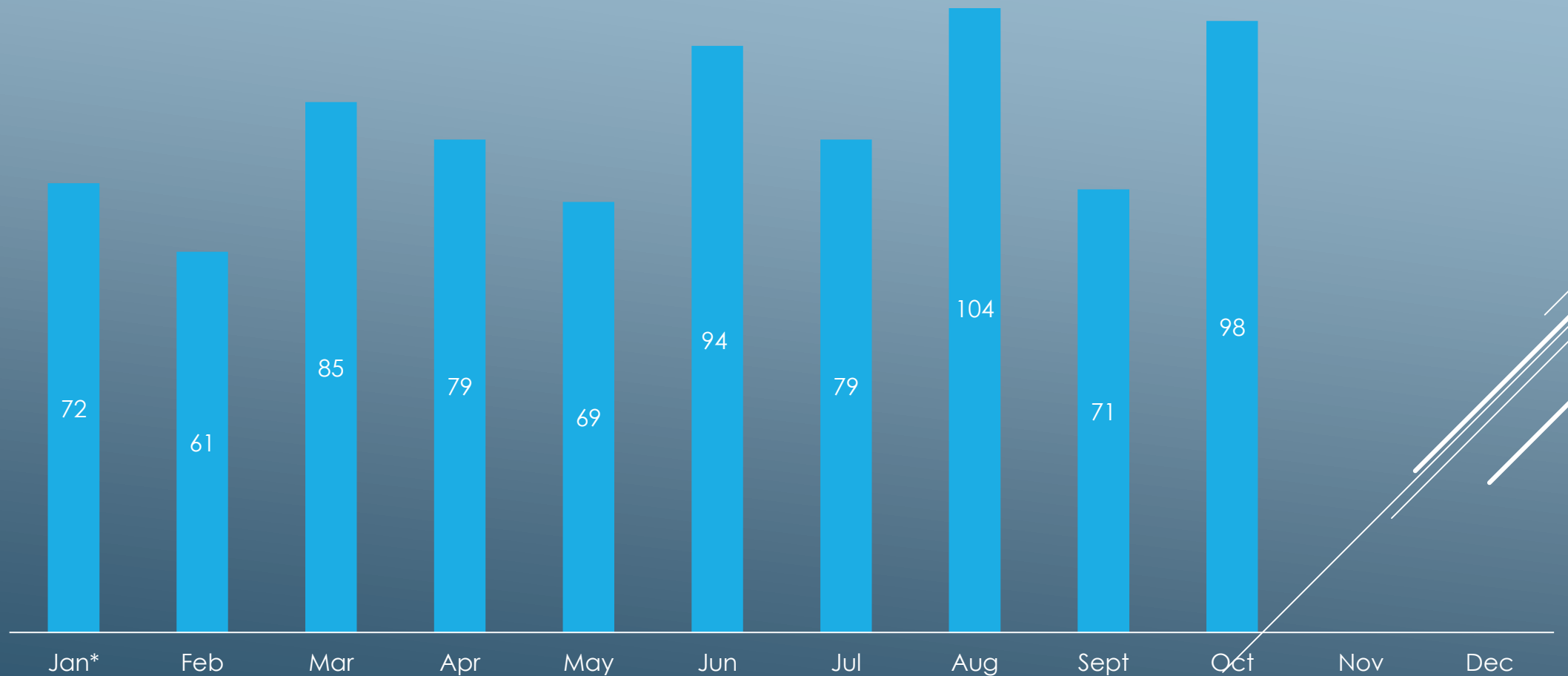

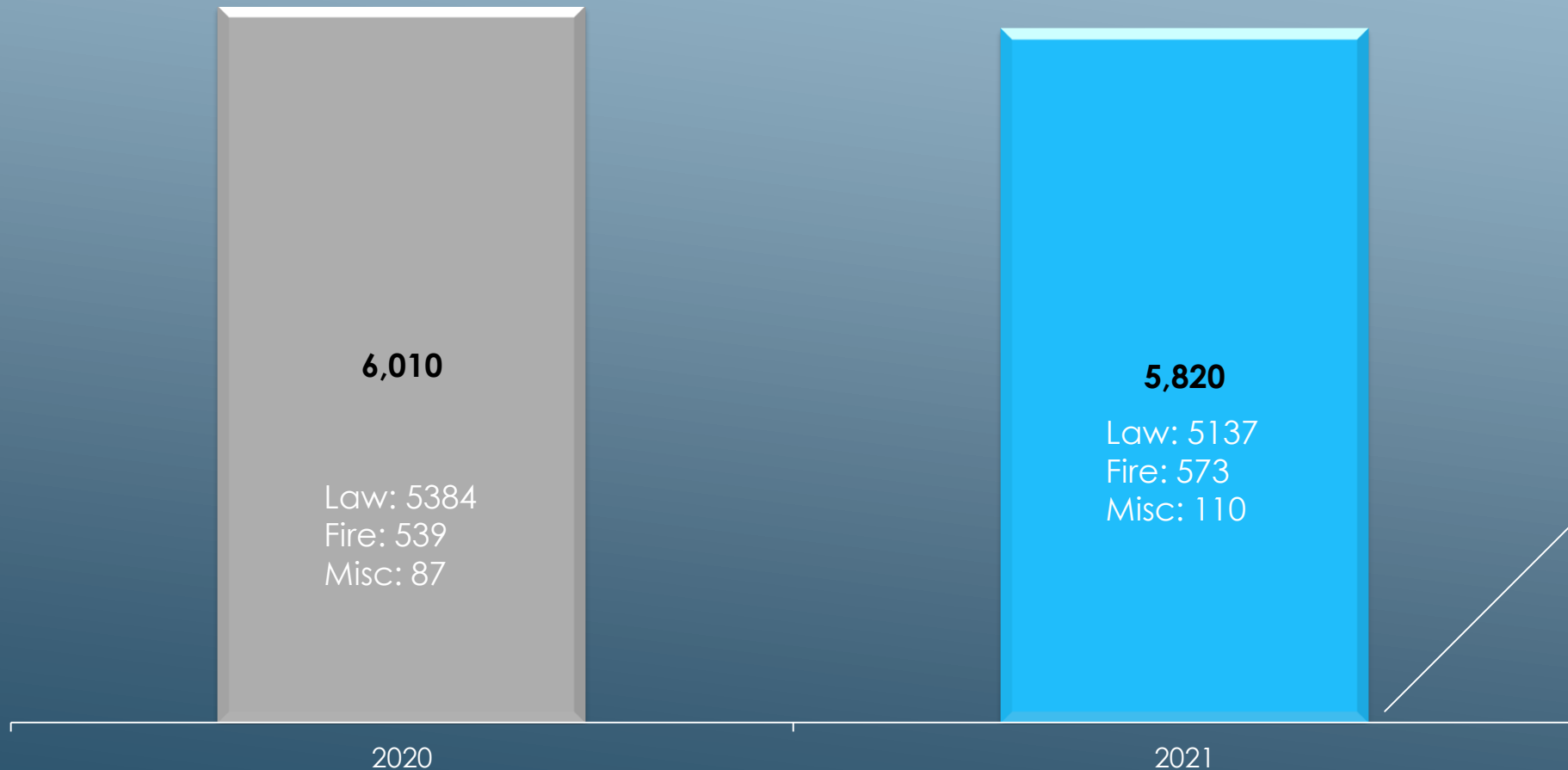
