

## ORDINANCE NO. 84-30

AN ORDINANCE RECOGNIZING THE ROSENBERG PARKS BOARD AS HAVING BEEN ESTABLISHED IN THE MONTH AND YEAR JUNE 1968 AND HAVING IT'S NAME CHANGED TO THE ROSENBERG PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD IN THE MONTH AND YEAR JULY 1975; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15 B-2 (a) THROUGH (e).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSENBERG, TEXAS:

That the Rosenberg Parks and Recreation Board is hereby recognized as being established and that Chapter 15 B of the Rosenberg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding Section 15 B-2 (a) through (e) as follows:

15 B-2 Rosenberg Parks and Recreation Board.

(a) It is hereby recognized that the Parks and Recreation Board was established in and for the City of Rosenberg, Texas. The Parks and Recreation Board shall consist of seven members who shall be appointed by the City Council. Members shall serve without compensation and each shall be a resident of the City of Rosenberg.

(b) The Rosenberg Parks and Recreation Board shall be appointed after each city election to serve a term of two years. The terms shall continue until their successors have been appointed and confirmed. There is no limit to the amount of terms a member may serve as long as member is active and participating.

(c) The Parks and Recreation Board shall organize by electing from their membership a chairperson, a vice-chairperson and a secretary each of whom shall hold office for one year, or until their successor shall have been elected. A majority of the members of the Parks and Recreation Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of its business. The Parks and Recreation Board may adopt its own rules of procedure for the conduction of its business. The Parks and Recreation Board shall keep a record of its proceedings and shall file the same with the City Secretary. The chairperson shall be entitled to vote upon any issue but shall have no veto power.

(d) The Parks and Recreation Board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council regarding policy matters pertaining to parks and/or recreation as follows:

(1) Solicit funds, gifts and requests for park acquisitions, additions and improvements from foundations & Civic Organizations.

(2) Review and make advisory recommendations to the City Council on proposed park acquisitions, additions and improvements.

(3) Review and make advisory recommendations on parks and recreation matters submitted by the Director of Parks and Recreation or the City Council.

(4) Promote and stimulate public interest in parks and recreation programs and to assist the Director of Parks and Recreation in solicitation of public and private agencies that may have a direct or indirect involvement in parks and recreation policies of the City of Rosenberg.

(5) The Parks and Recreation Board shall have no right, power or authority to obligate or bind the City of Rosenberg in any matter whatsoever.



(e) The Parks and Recreation Board may establish it's own rules as to attendance of its members to its meetings and in futherance of such, the Board may, by a majority vote, expel any member who, in the opinion of the Board has missed an unreasonable number of meetings without a valid reason.


PASSED AND APPROVED at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Rosenberg, at which a quorum was present on the first reading the 15th day of January, 1985.


