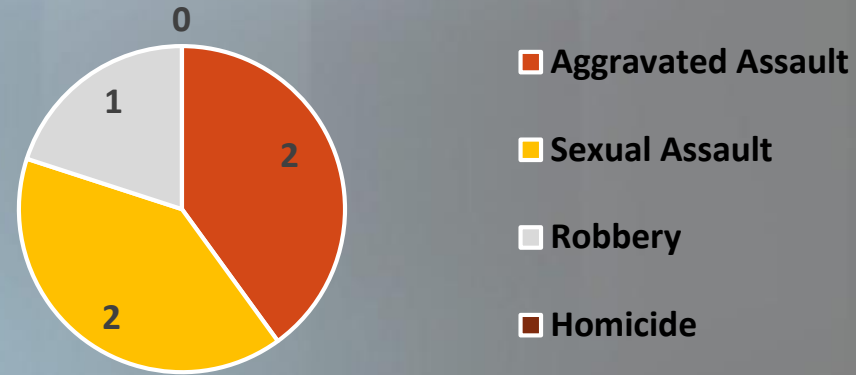

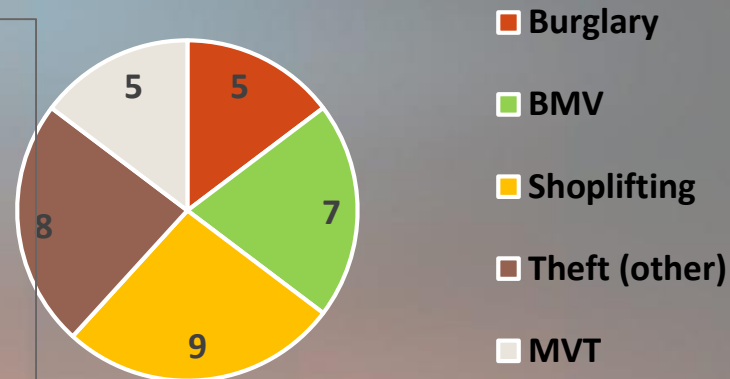

February 2018 Part 1: Person Crimes

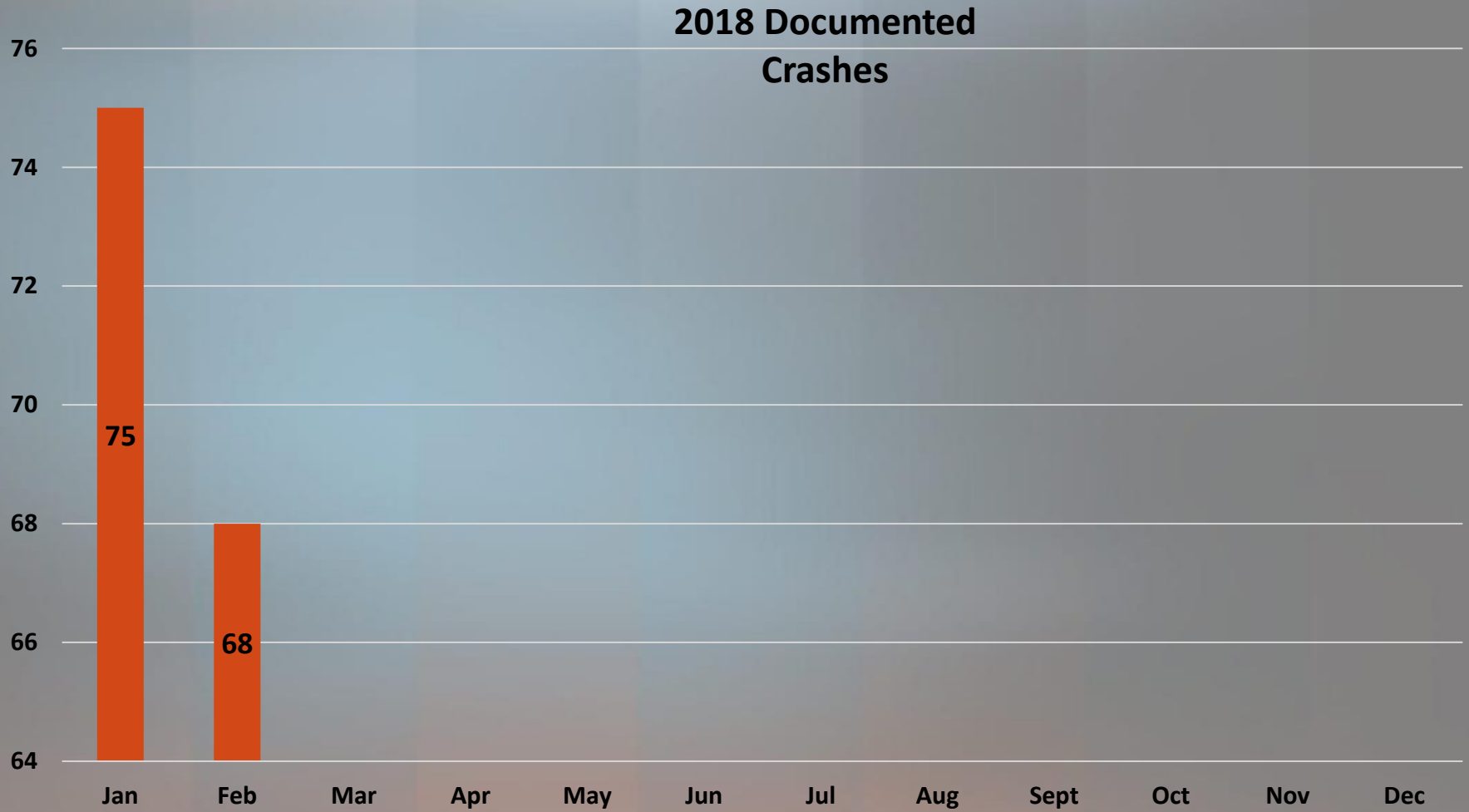


February 2018 Part 1: Property Crimes
