- Communications Specialist: (6) openings

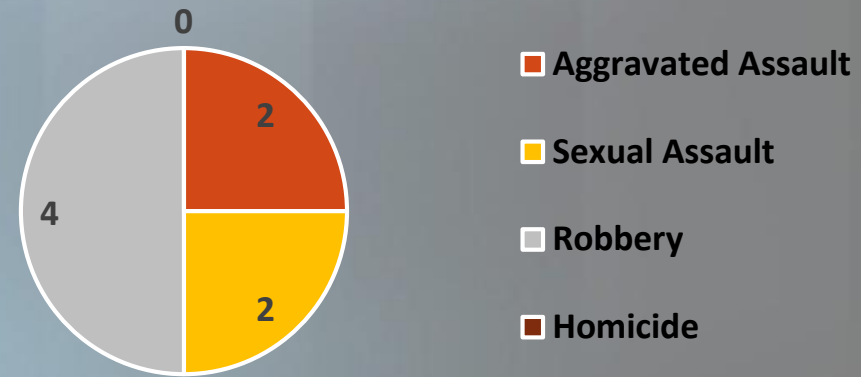
# Communications Division

- 9,172 Calls received
  - 7,562 10-digit non-emergency calls received
  - 1,610 9-1-1 calls received
  - Average 834 calls per Telecommunications Officer (TCO)
- 5,951 Dispatched calls for service
  - 4,325 Law incidents
  - 541 Fire incidents
  - 1085 Other incidents (water, off-duty animal control, etc)

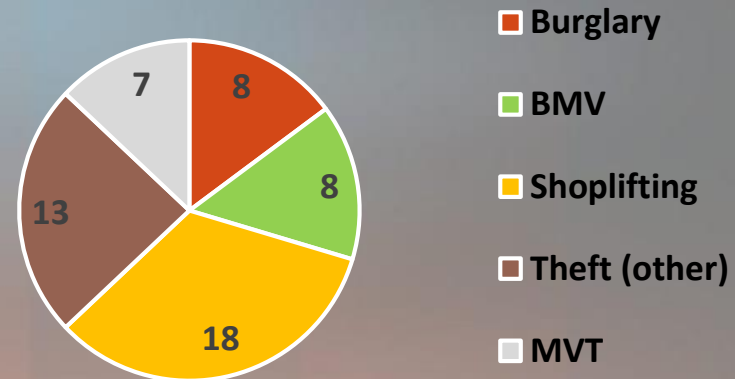
# Patrol Division

## March 2018 Part 1: Person Crimes

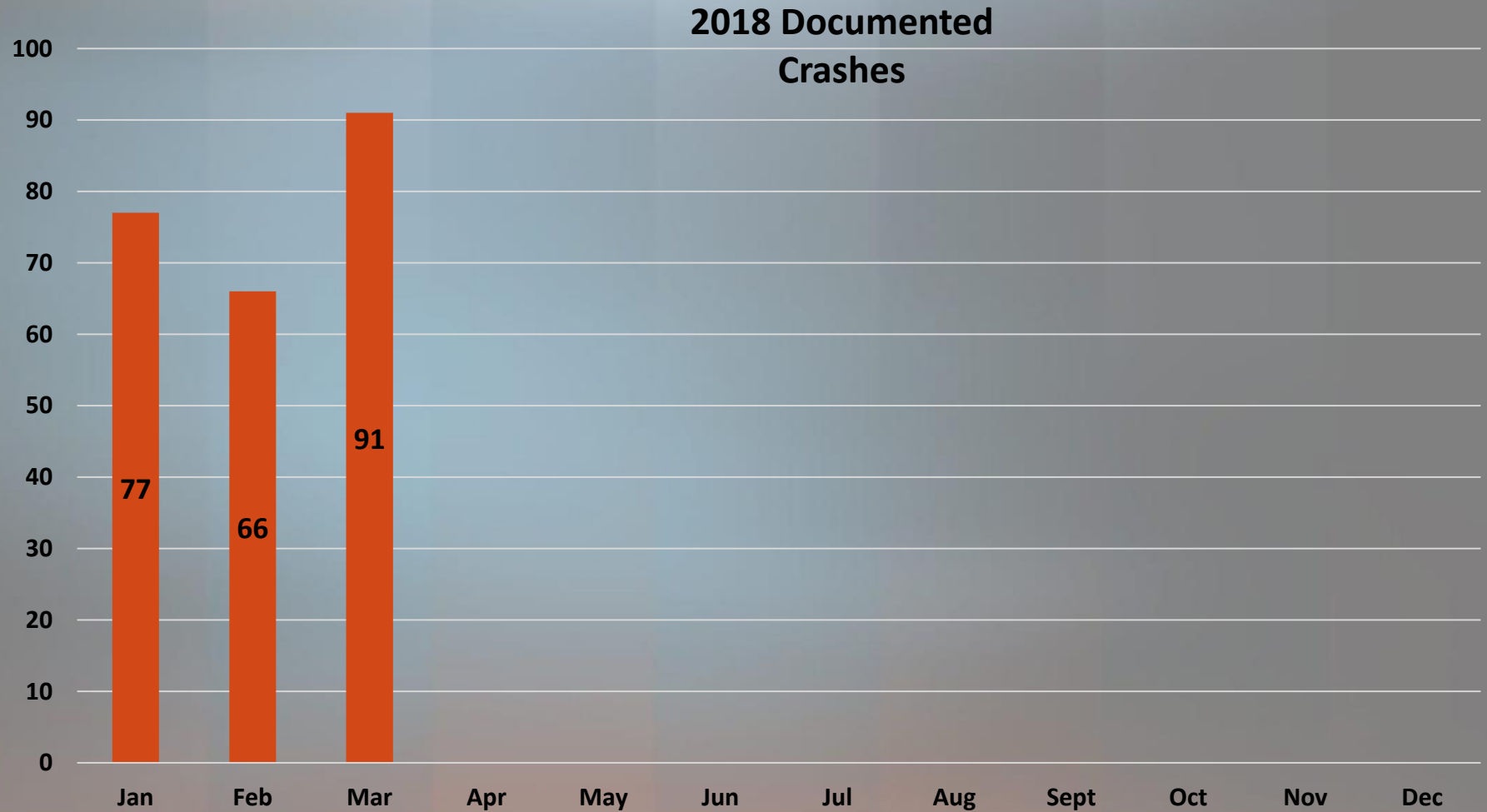


## March 2018 Part 1: Property Crimes
