- The Red Hat Society, Chapter 70009, The Hatpin Harlequins, presented the shelter with a check for \$550 from sales of the ladies' cookbooks.

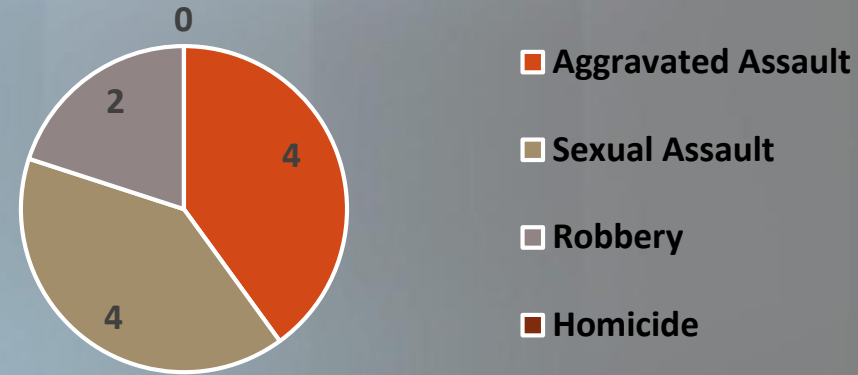

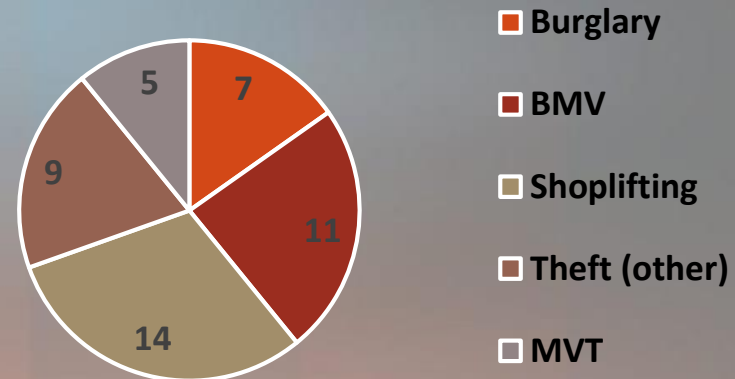
Patrol Division

March 2018 Part 1: Person Crimes

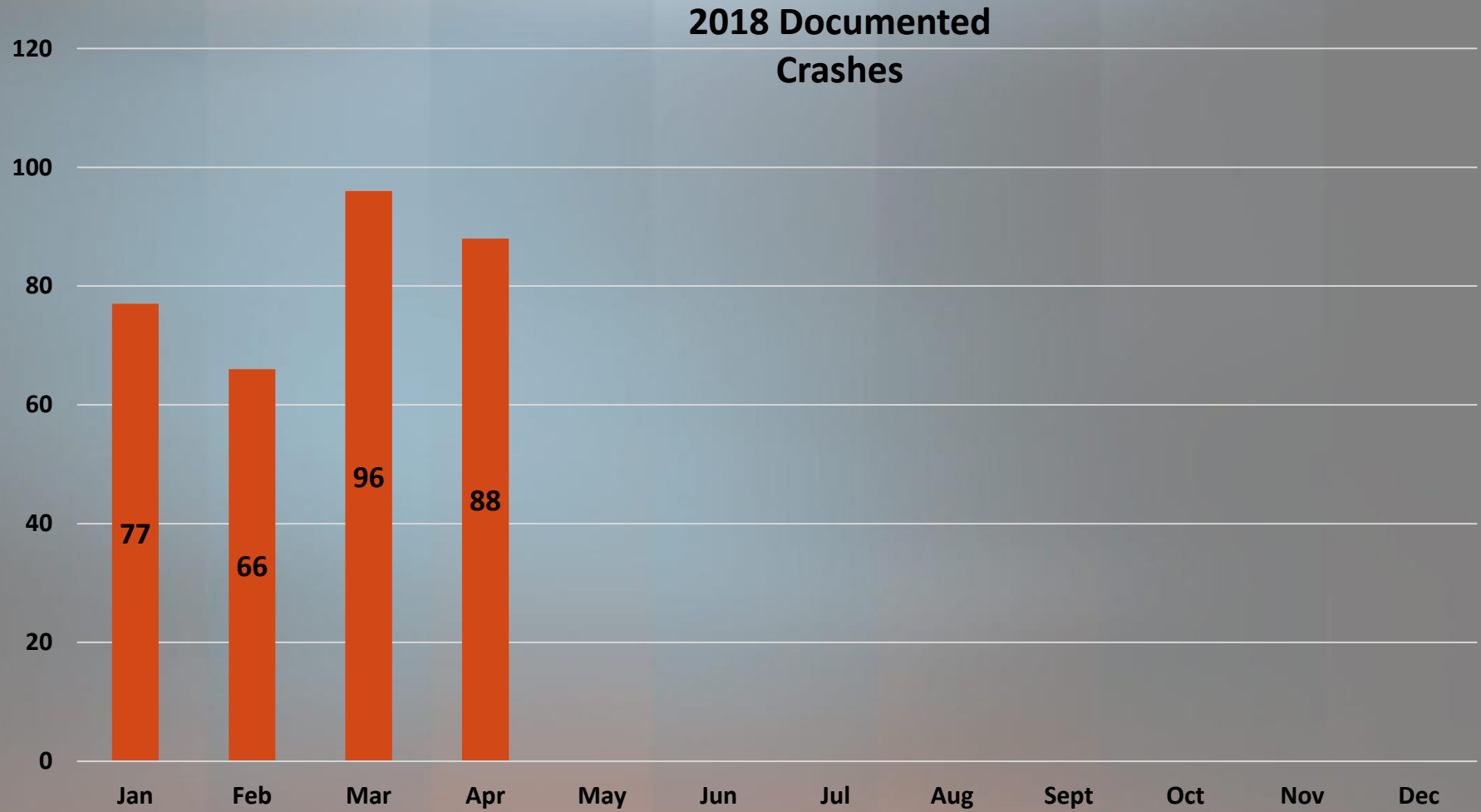


March 2018 Part 1: Property Crimes
