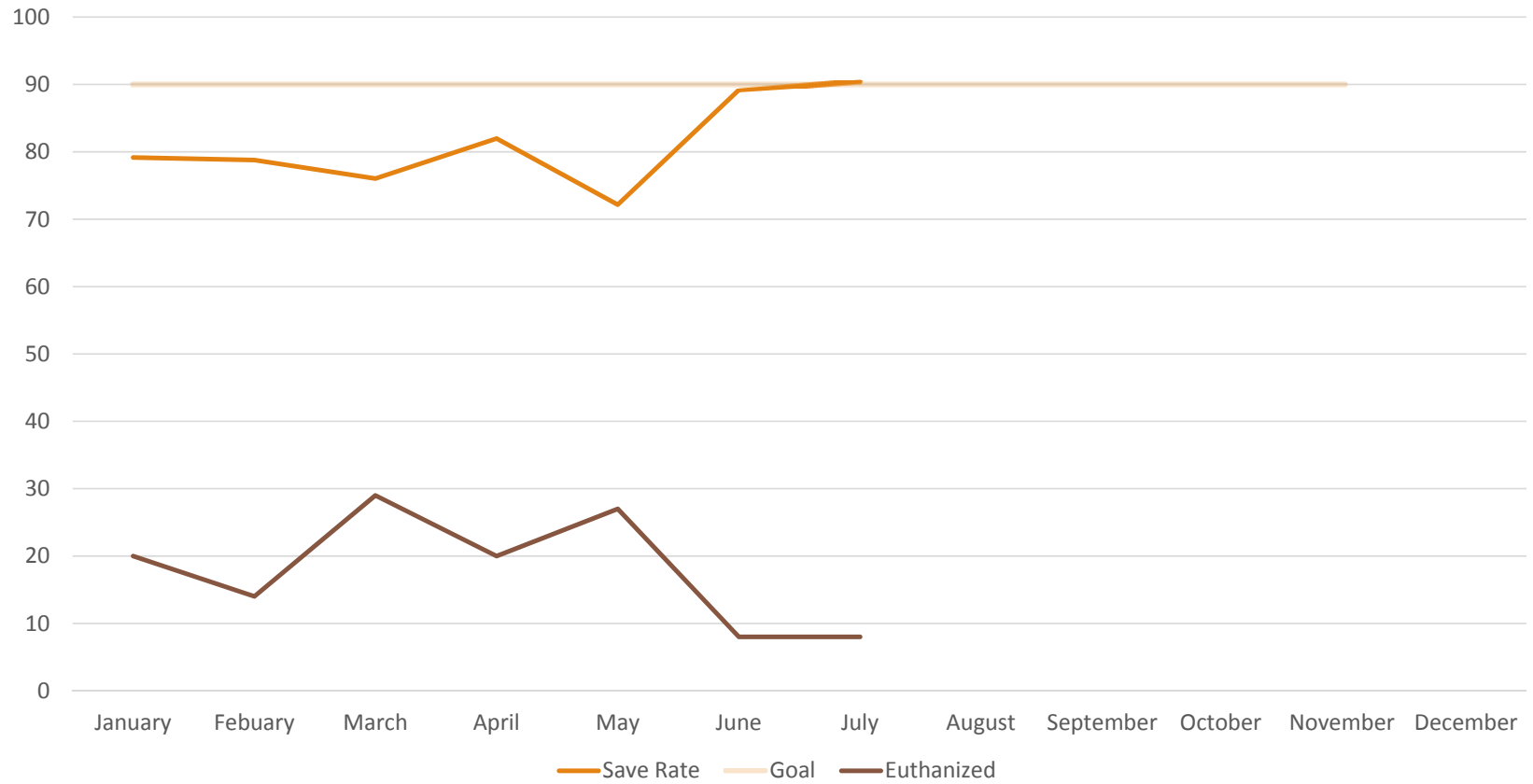
Animal Control Shelter Advisory Board

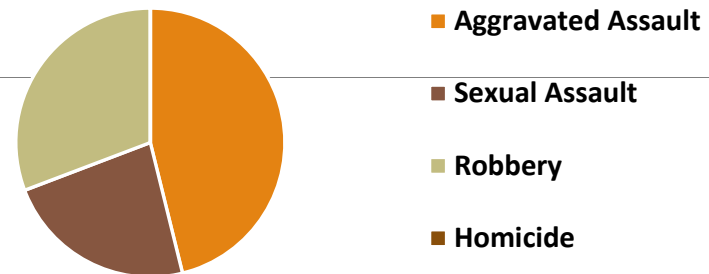

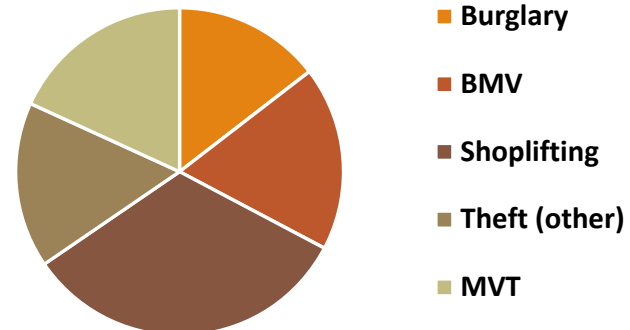

July 2018 Part 1: Person Crimes



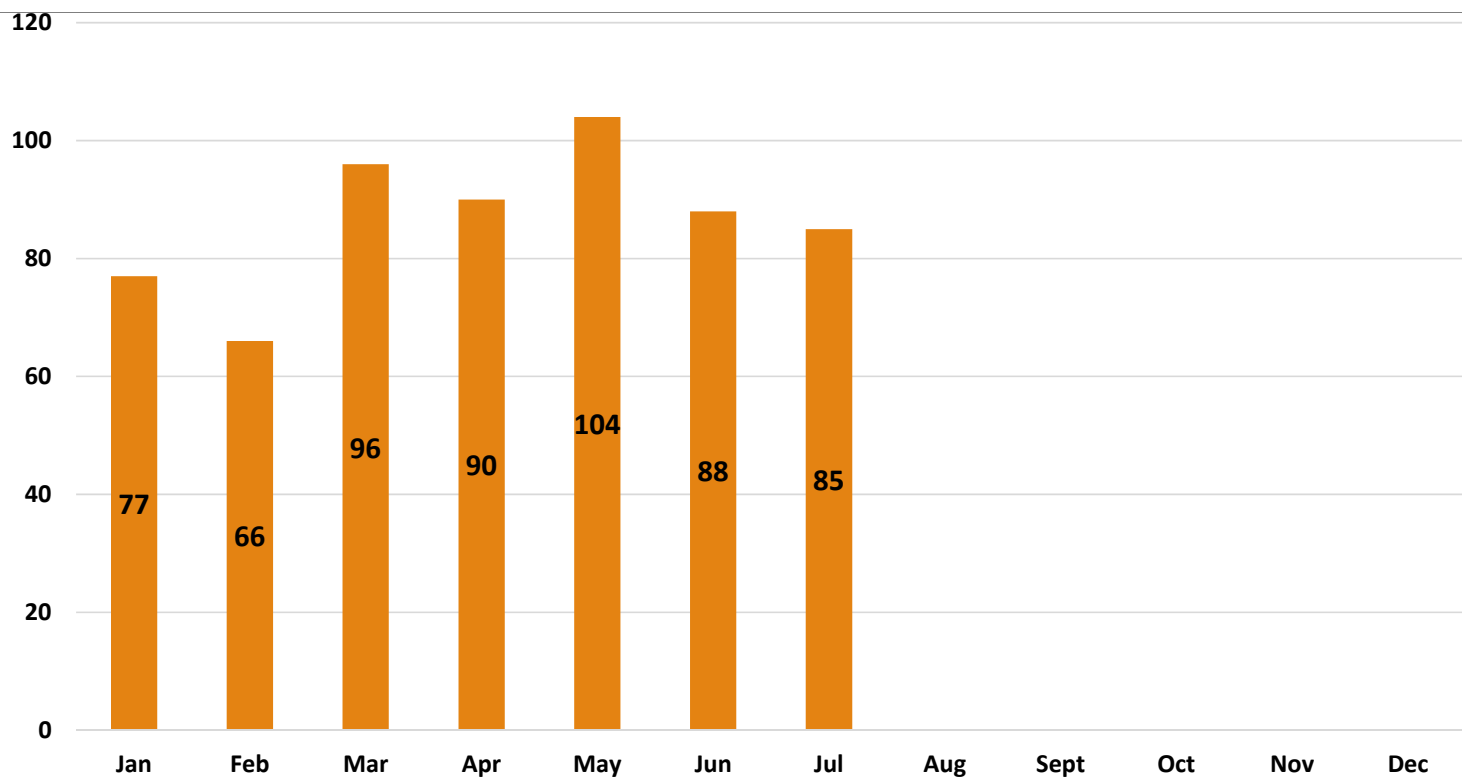
July 2018 Part 1: Property Crimes

School Resource Division
