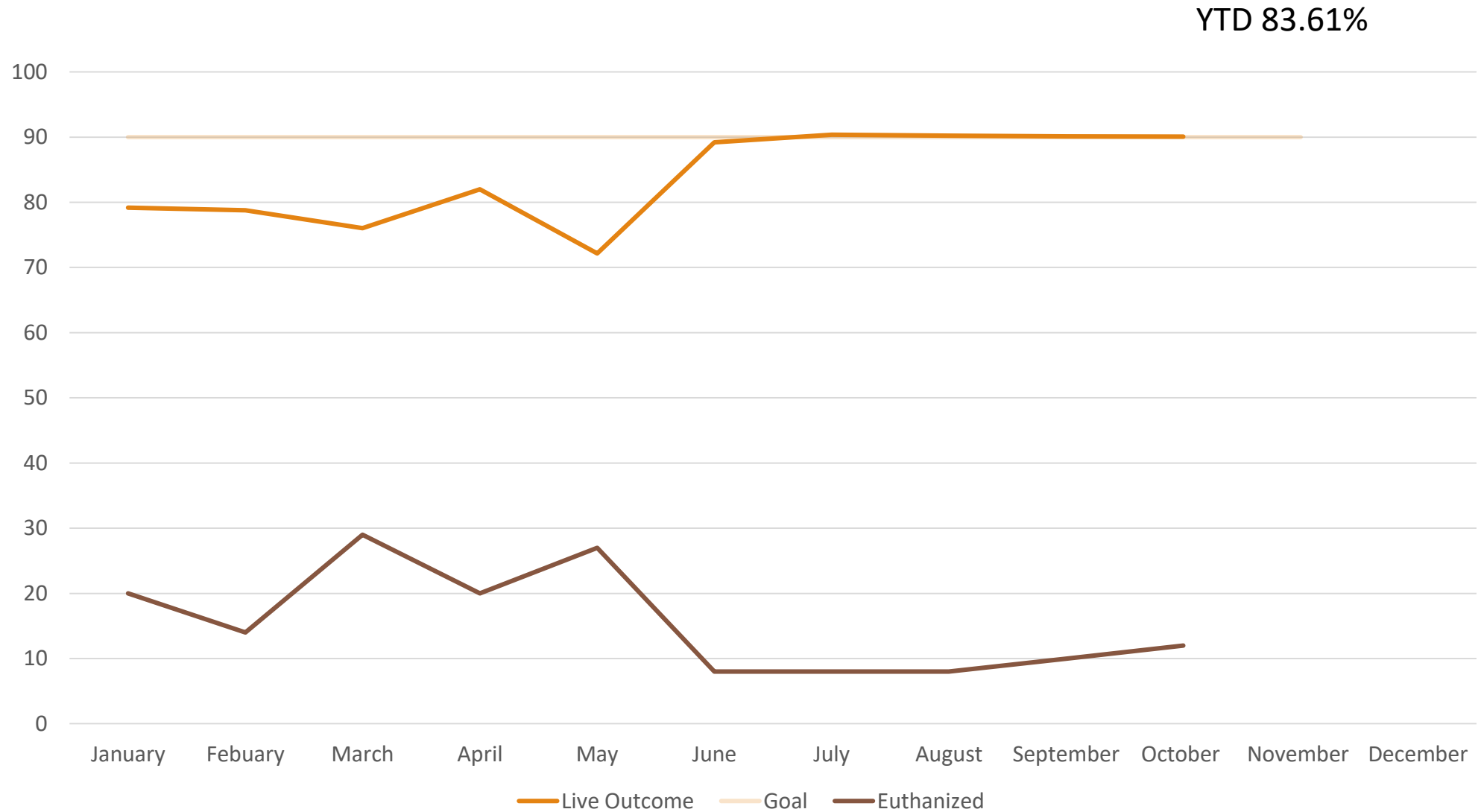

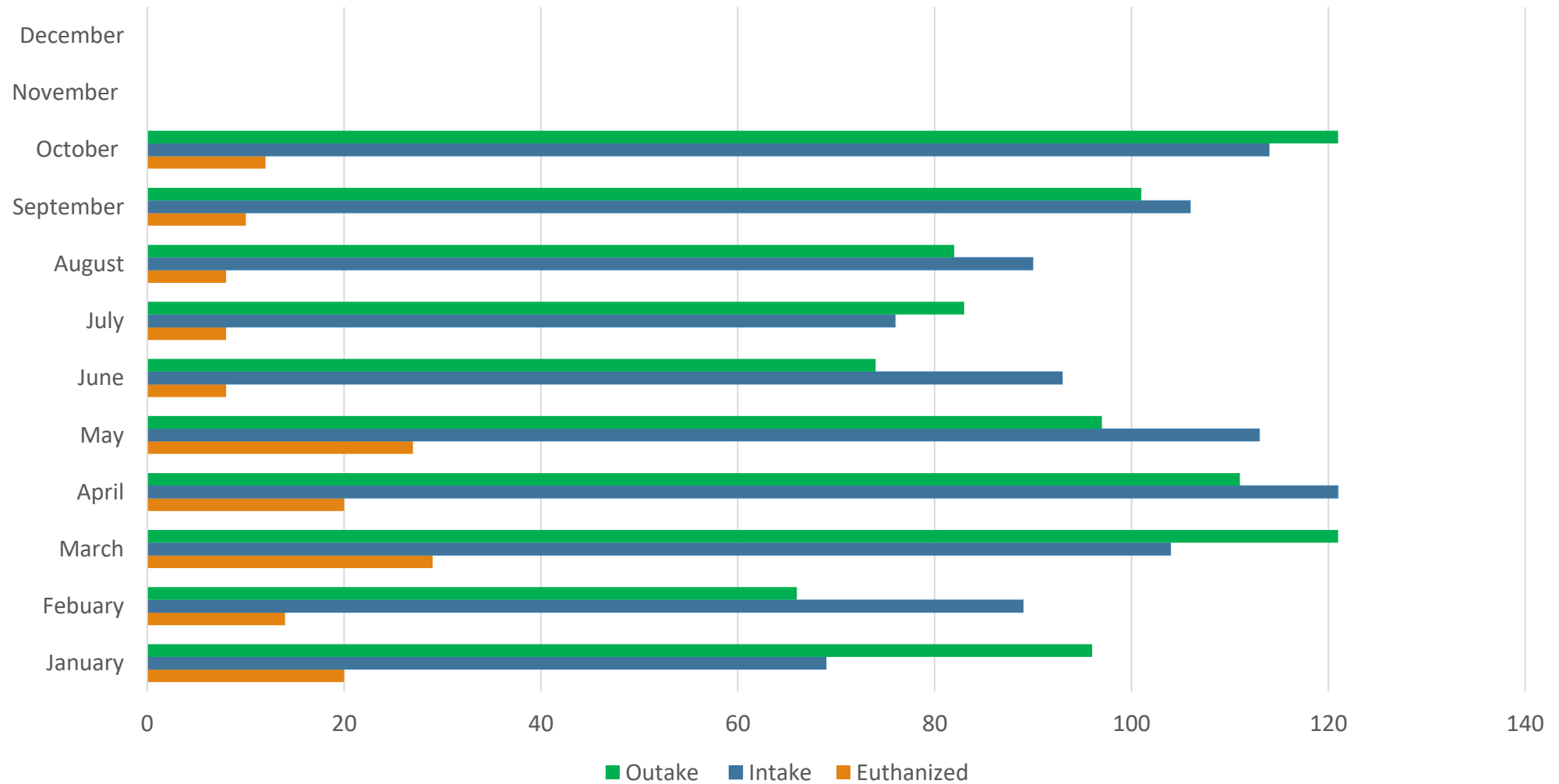
# Animal Control and Shelter YTD information

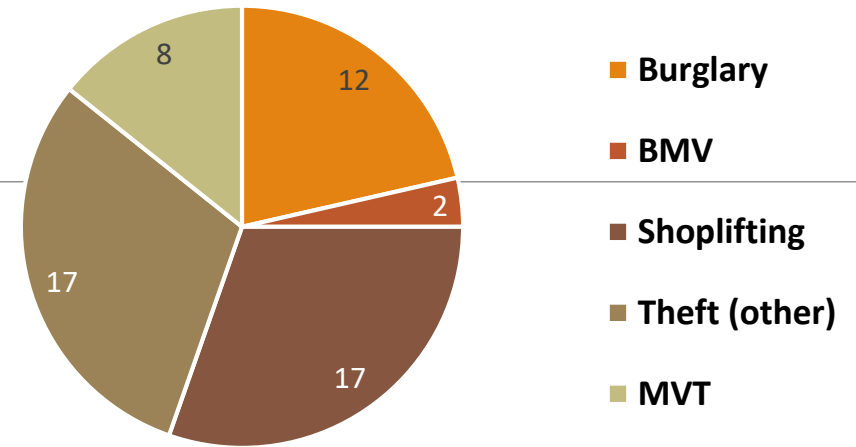

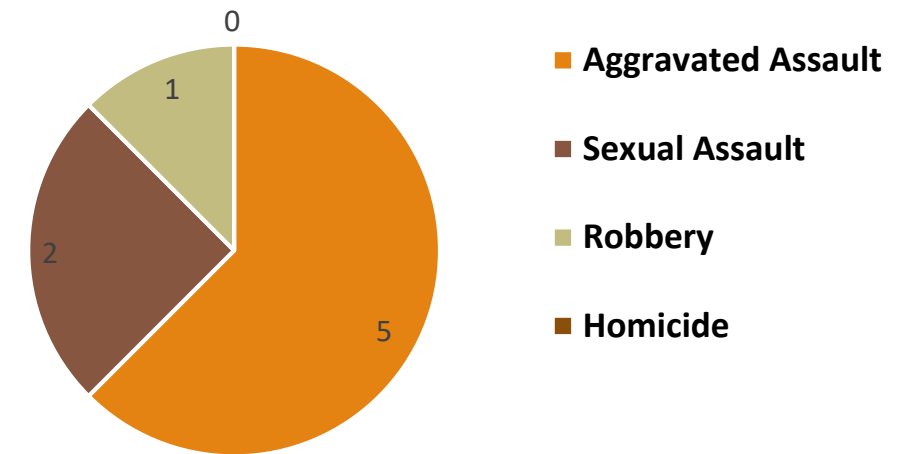

# New Assistant Chief

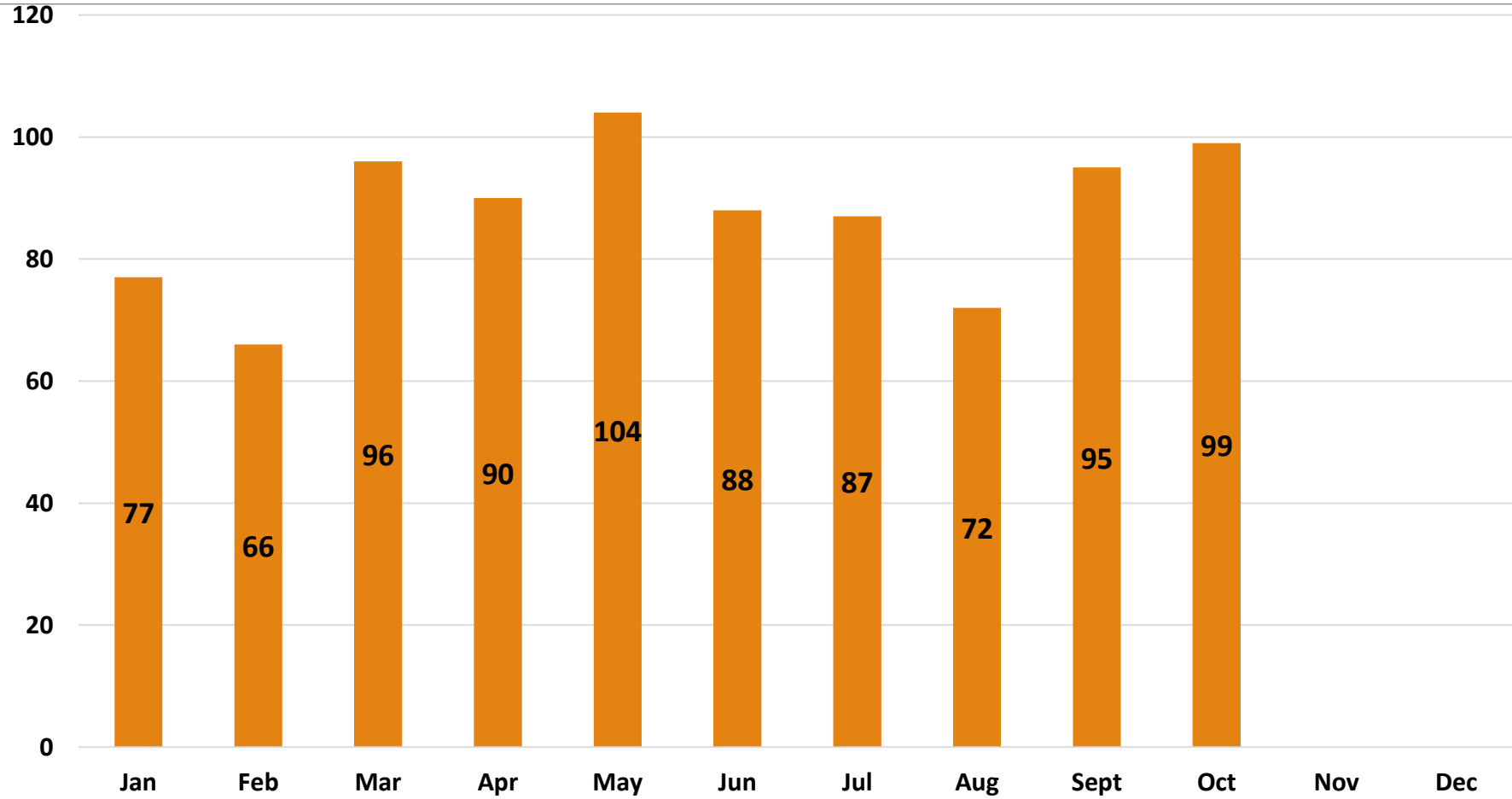
