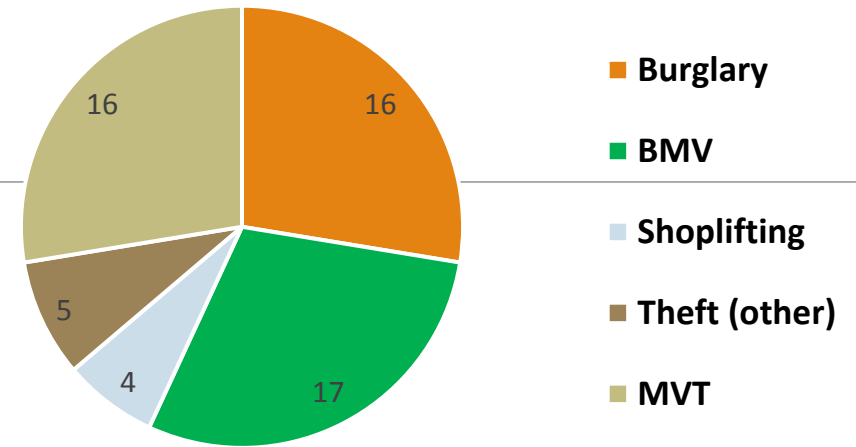

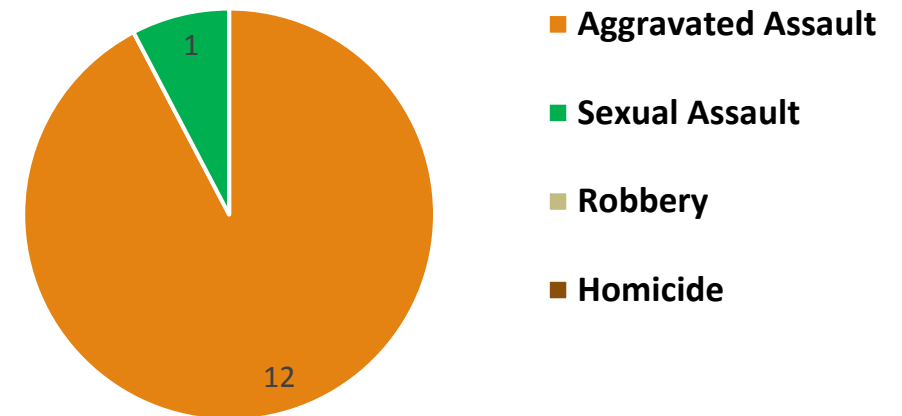

December 2018 Part 1: Property Crimes

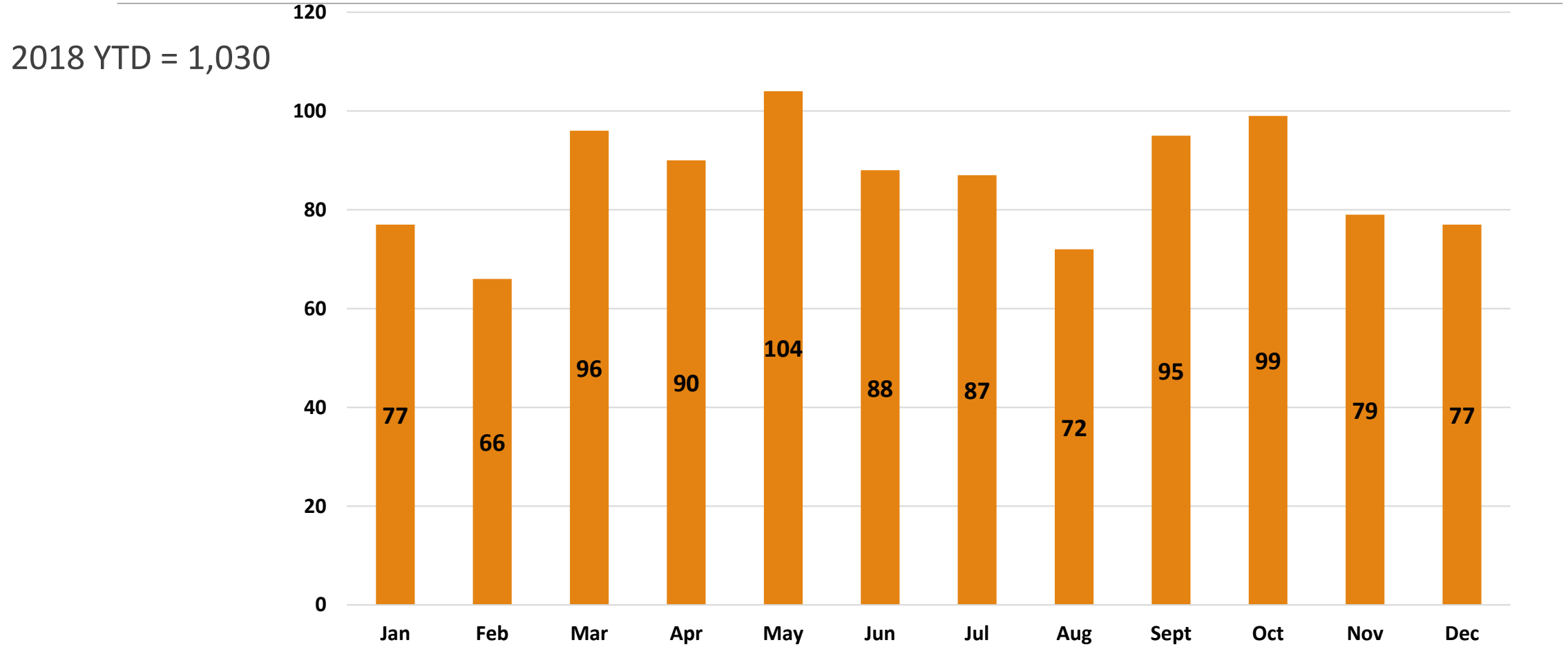


December 2018 Part 1: Person Crimes
