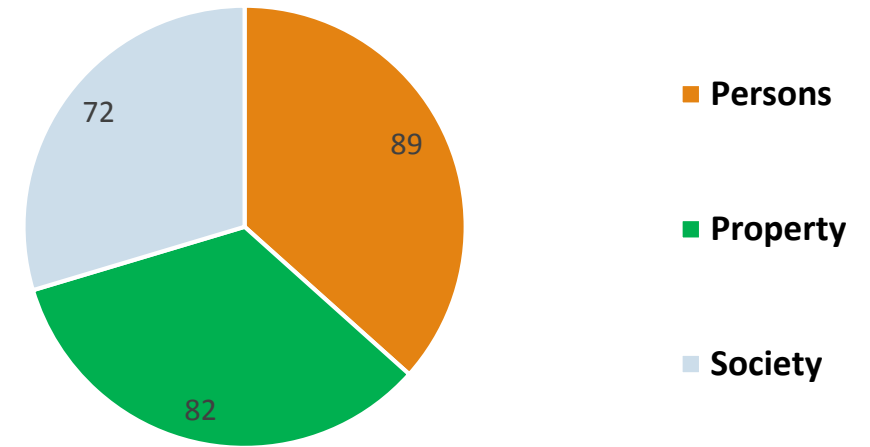

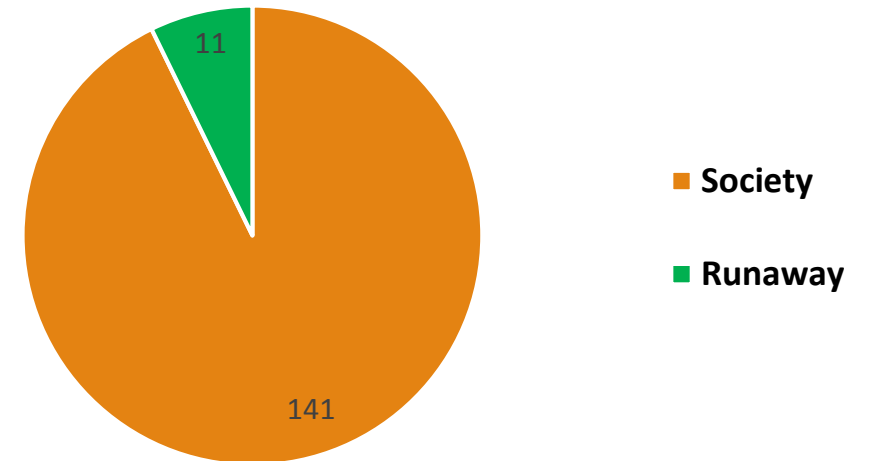

January 2019 Group A Crimes

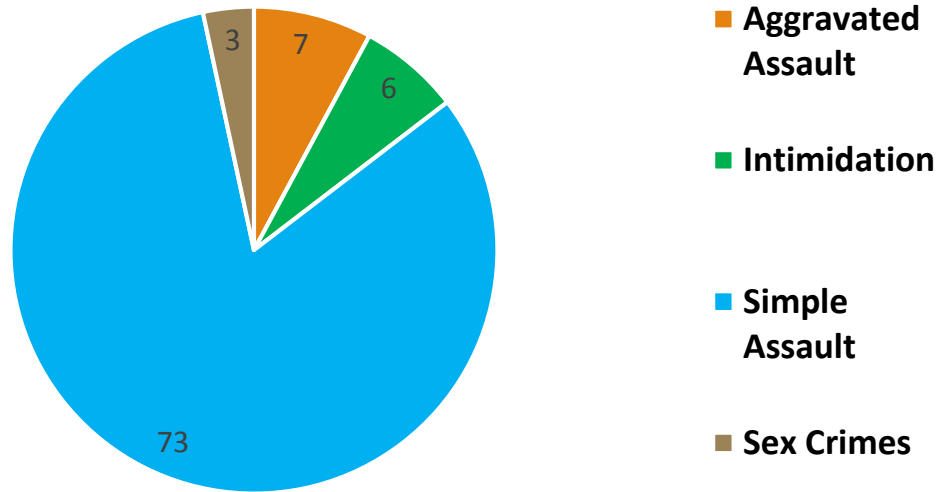


January 2019 Group B Crimes

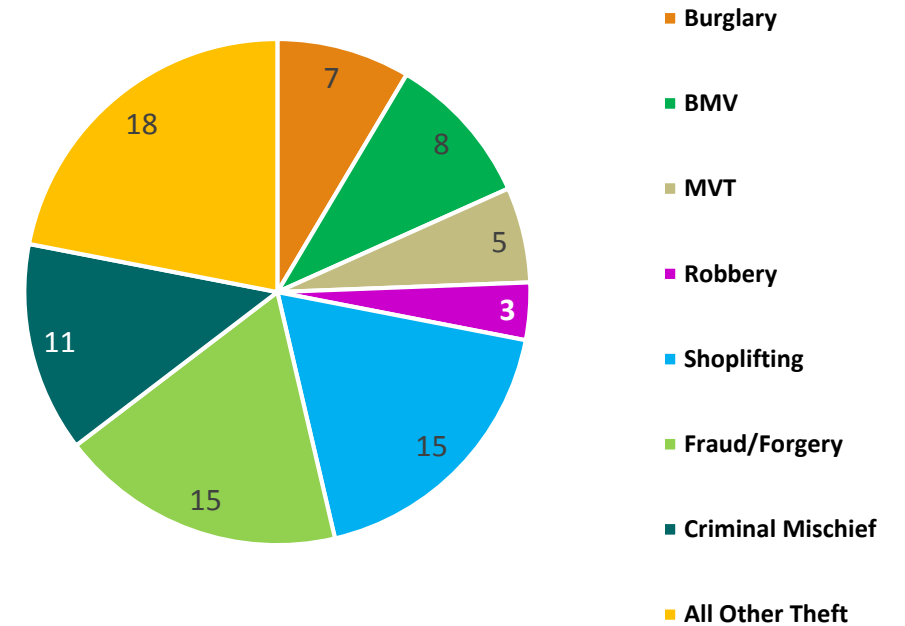

January 2019 Group A Persons Crimes

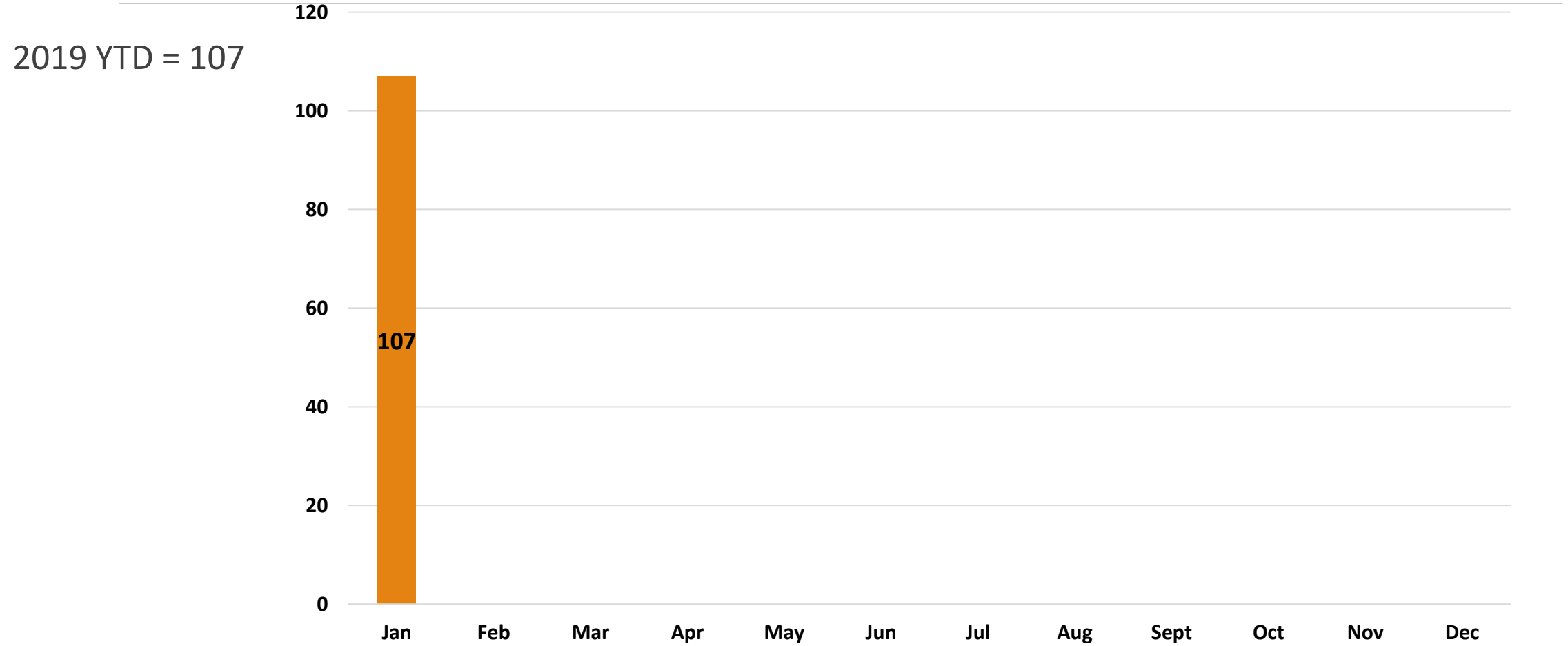


January 2019 Group A Property Crimes

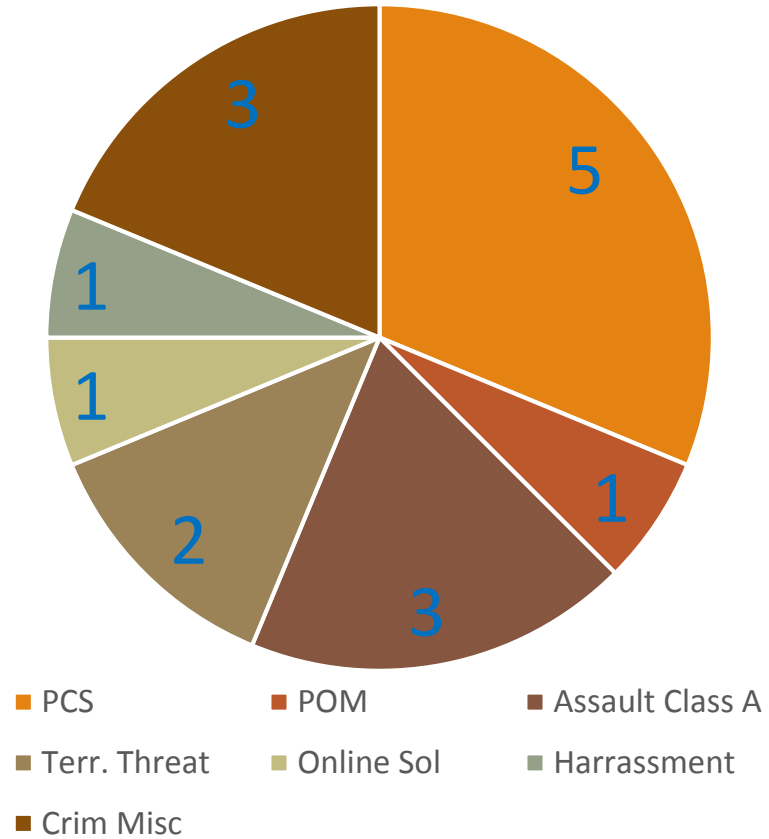
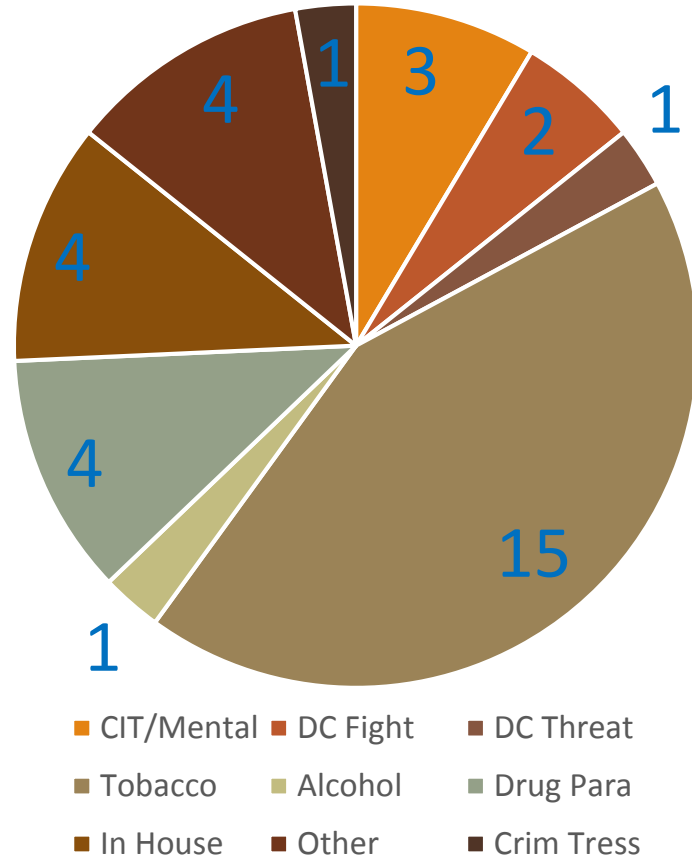
