ADDRESSING COMMENTS



Live Release Rates are calculated by dividing the month's live outcomes by ALL of its final outcomes. That number is then multiplied by 100.

Foster placements are not considered outcomes.



While the shelter has maintained a low inventory average since COVID, this does not mean that operations are limited.

September 2020's intake total of 144 was the highest ever recorded.



Since COVID, the shelter's staff team of 5 has strengthened relationships through programs and focused on strategies that place more animals.

The significantly shortened length of stay statistics this year are a direct reflection of persistence and hard work.
